**\*Transition Care** is defined as support given to empanelled patients ensuring coordination of health care services during the movement between health care providers and settings. These are important events when a patient's condition and care needs change. The PCMH Care Management Model focuses on ensuring appropriate ED visits, avoiding preventable hospital admissions and reducing hospital readmissions. Empanelled patients within a PCMH are the responsibility of the PCMH team at all levels of care and across practice settings.

**\*\*Medical Home Network Connect:** MHN Connect is a web-based tool that supports management of care transitions.
