



## QUICK FACTS ABOUT ICAAP

### Pediatrician Members

ICAAP has approximately 2,300 members, representing over 80% of Illinois' pediatricians. ICAAP has members throughout the state but nearly 70% live or work in Cook and Collar Counties, and some rural and southern Illinois counties have very few or no pediatricians. A staff of 17 FTEs, many consultants, and a committed core of volunteers keep the Chapter running and work to ensure ICAAP fulfills its mission.

### Publications

ICAAP updates members on the latest child health news in several ways:

- The *Illinois Pediatrician* is a quarterly newsletter published by ICAAP and mailed to all members.
- *ICAAP-lets* is a weekly update distributed to over 2,300 members and partners via e-mail.
- Periodic topic specific emails on Obesity and Child Development are sent to members and interested parties.
- ICAAP's Web site ([www.illinoisaaap.org](http://www.illinoisaaap.org)) provides current health news updates

### Child Health Committees

A dozen committees tackle specific child health issues, such as school health, child development, children with disabilities, obesity prevention and treatment, and other topics. Committees provide a forum for ICAAP members to share information across their institutions and regions and are often involved in legislative issues.

### Educational Programs

ICAAP administers many programs in continuing medical education and Maintenance of Certification to physicians, nurses and other healthcare providers. Programs are delivered to physicians and other pediatric health care providers via in-person trainings and the Chapter's online education system. These include screening for developmental and social-emotional delays and maternal depression, obesity, immunizations, oral health and fluoride varnish application, transitioning youth to adult health care and more. ICAAP also hosts an Annual Conference, and the Autism, Behavior, and Complex Medical Needs Conference.

### Partnerships with State Agencies

Key state agencies, such as the Illinois Department of Public Health and the Illinois Department of Healthcare and Family Services, work closely with ICAAP on a variety of issues that affect pediatricians and the children they serve. ICAAP seeks to partner with state agencies whenever possible.

### Legislative Affairs

ICAAP's Committee on Government Affairs works closely with grassroots members and the Chapter's legislative consultant to advocate for Illinois children and pediatricians. ICAAP provides guidance to legislators and policy makers on topics related to the health and wellbeing of children in Illinois.
