



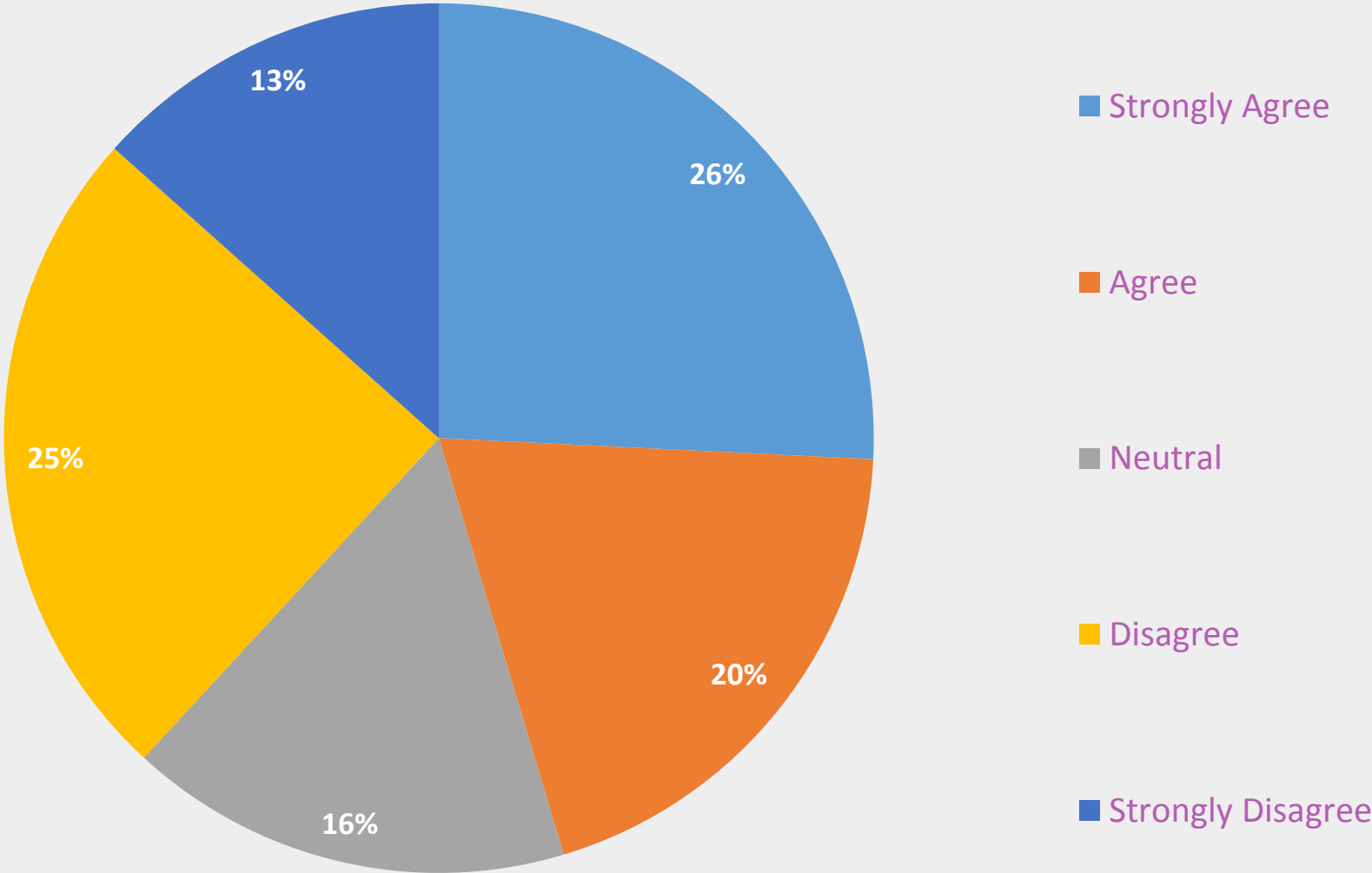

PROVIDER LACK OF INTEREST IN ADOLESCENT HEALTH ISSUES

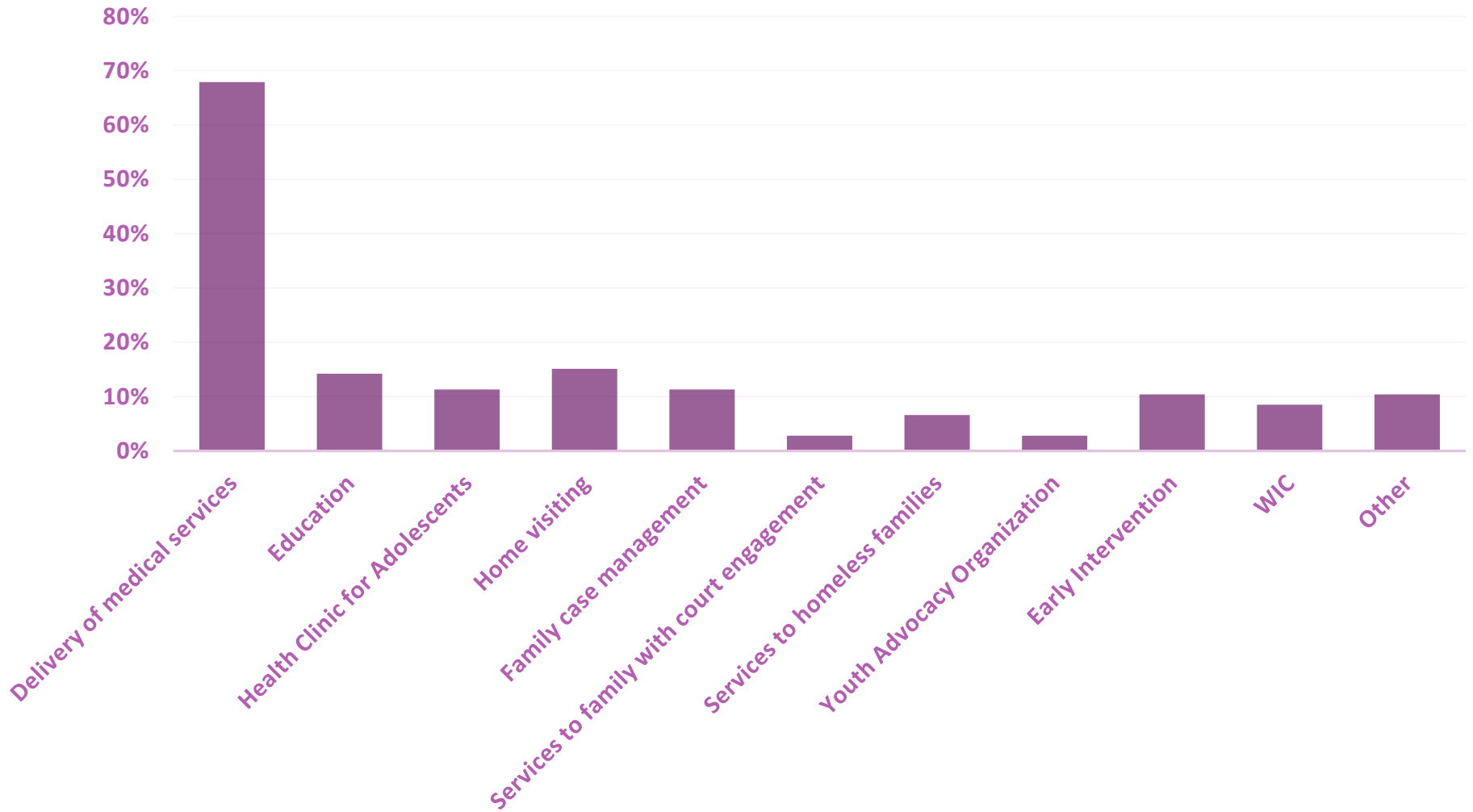


Organizations Responding

- Illinois: 31%

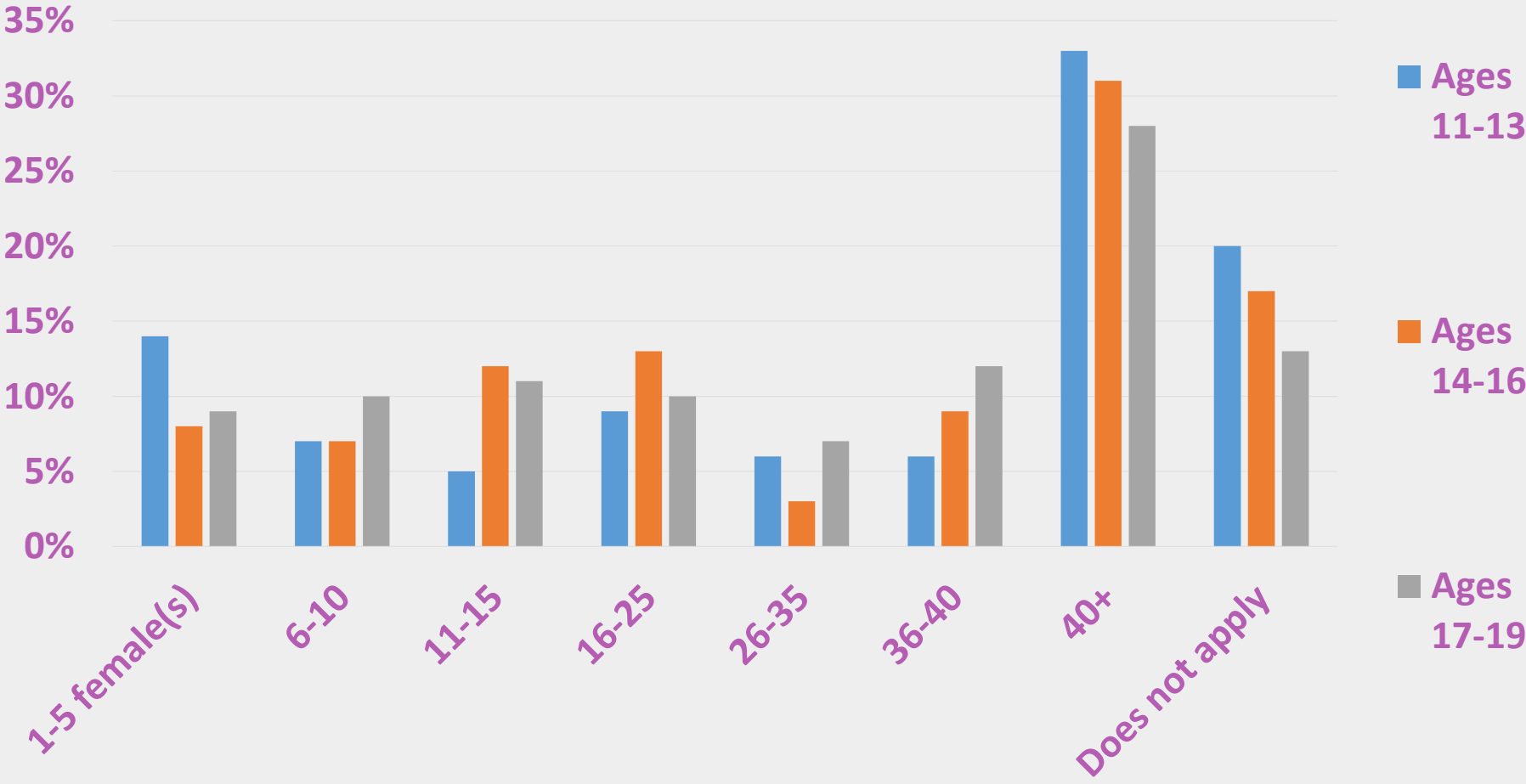

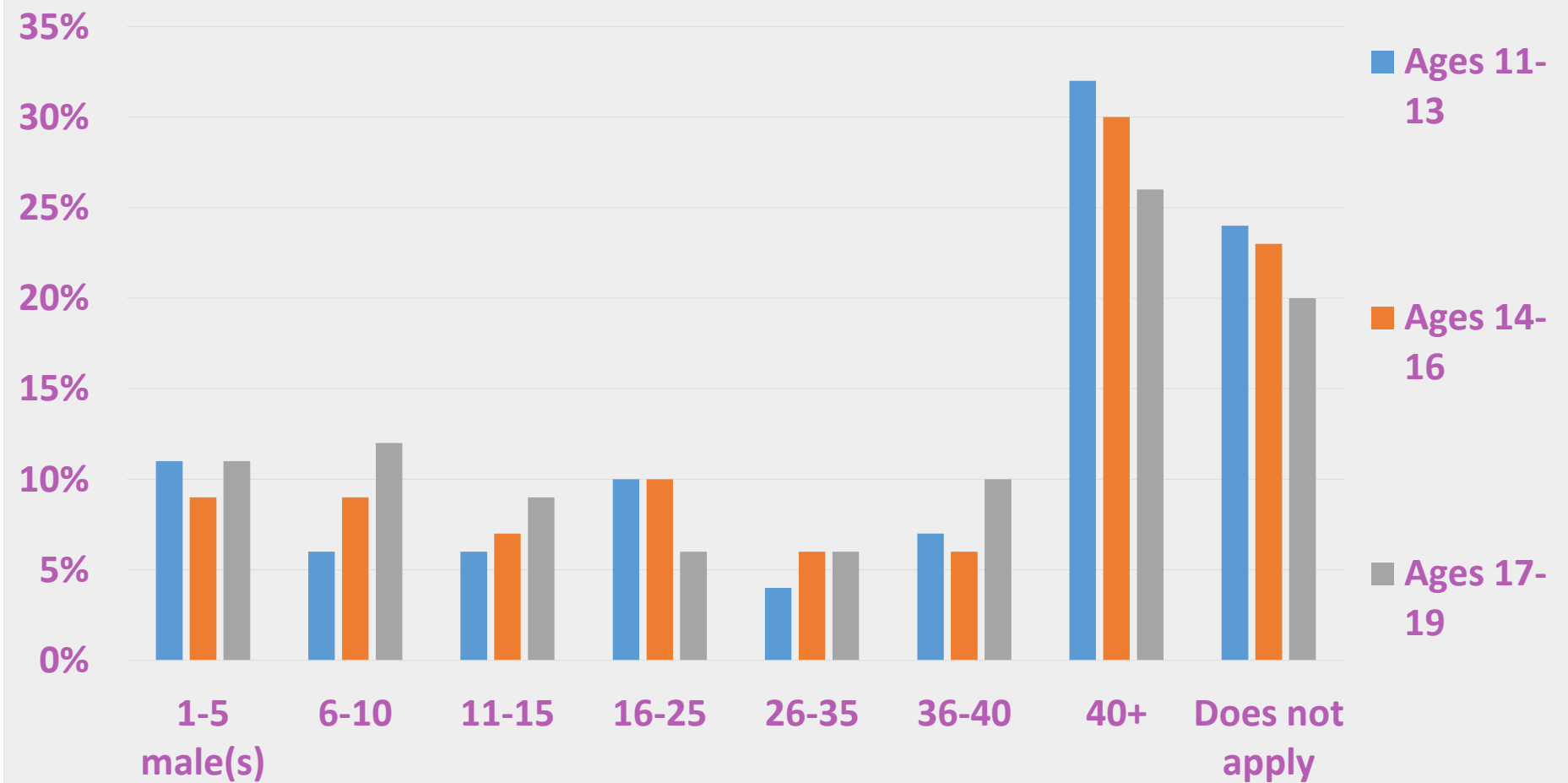

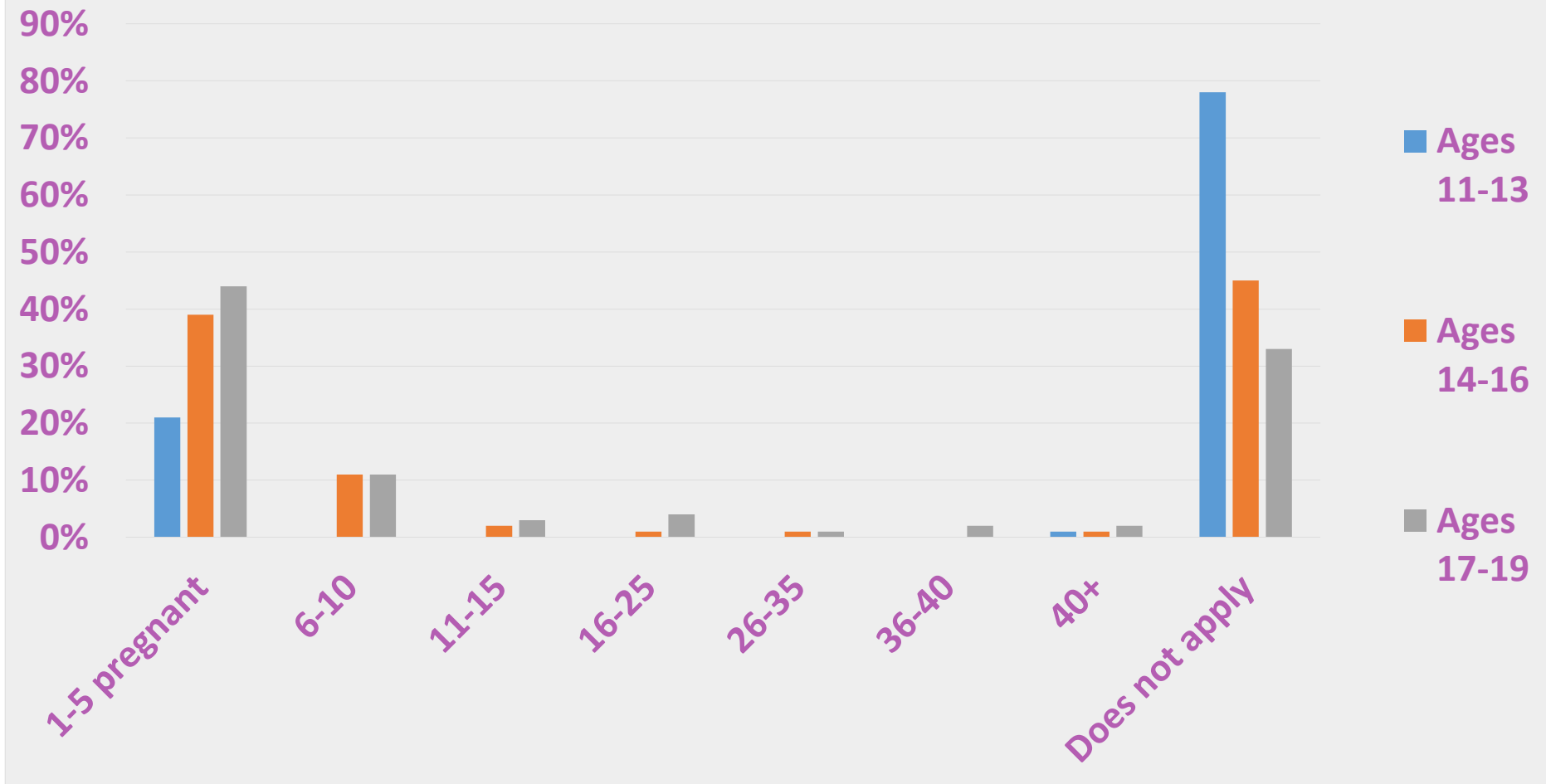
In the past year, how many adolescent females were part of your caseload? (Adolescent 11-19)



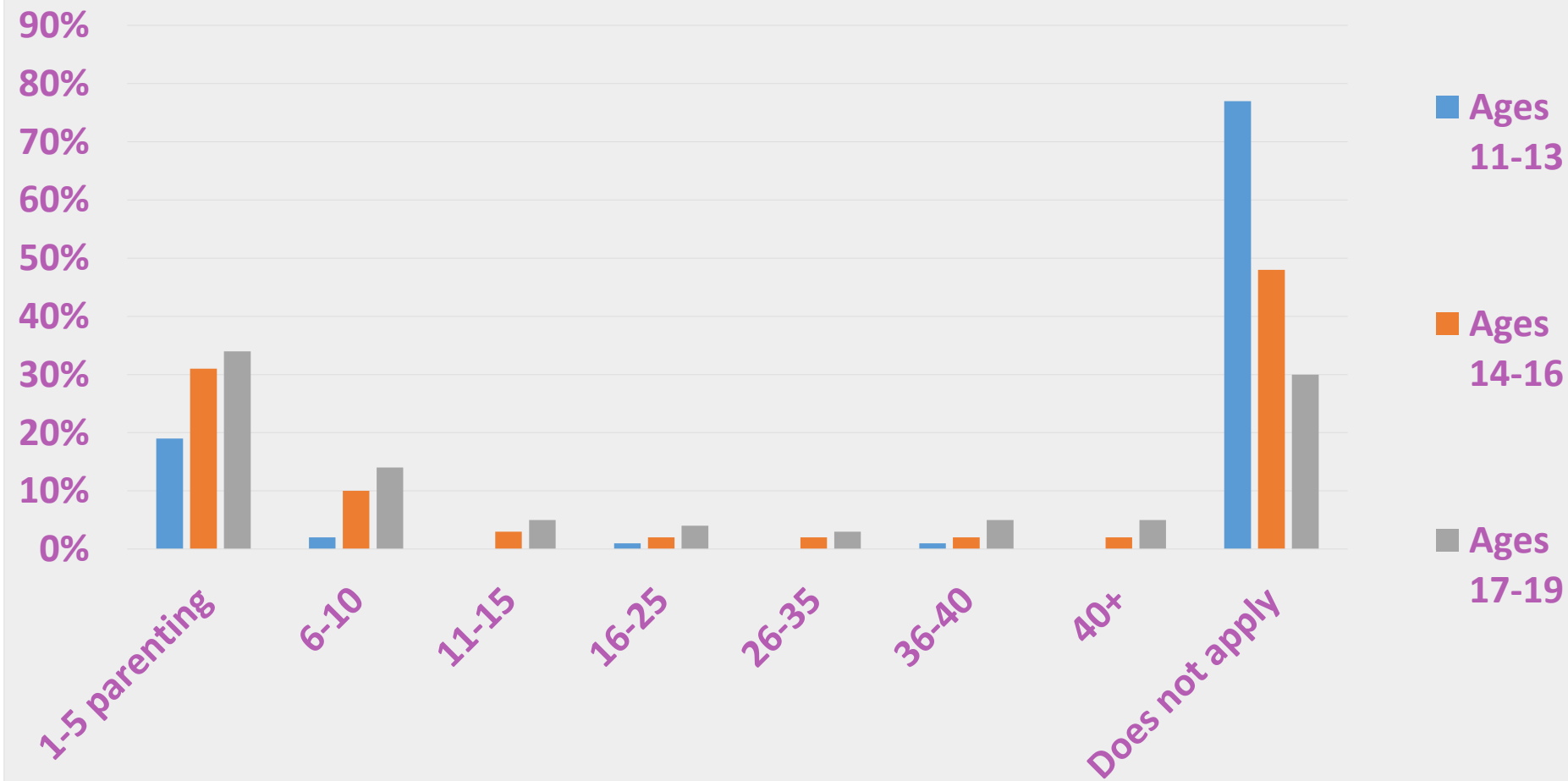
In the past year, how many **adolescent males** were part of your caseload? (Adolescent 11-19)

Participant Feedback

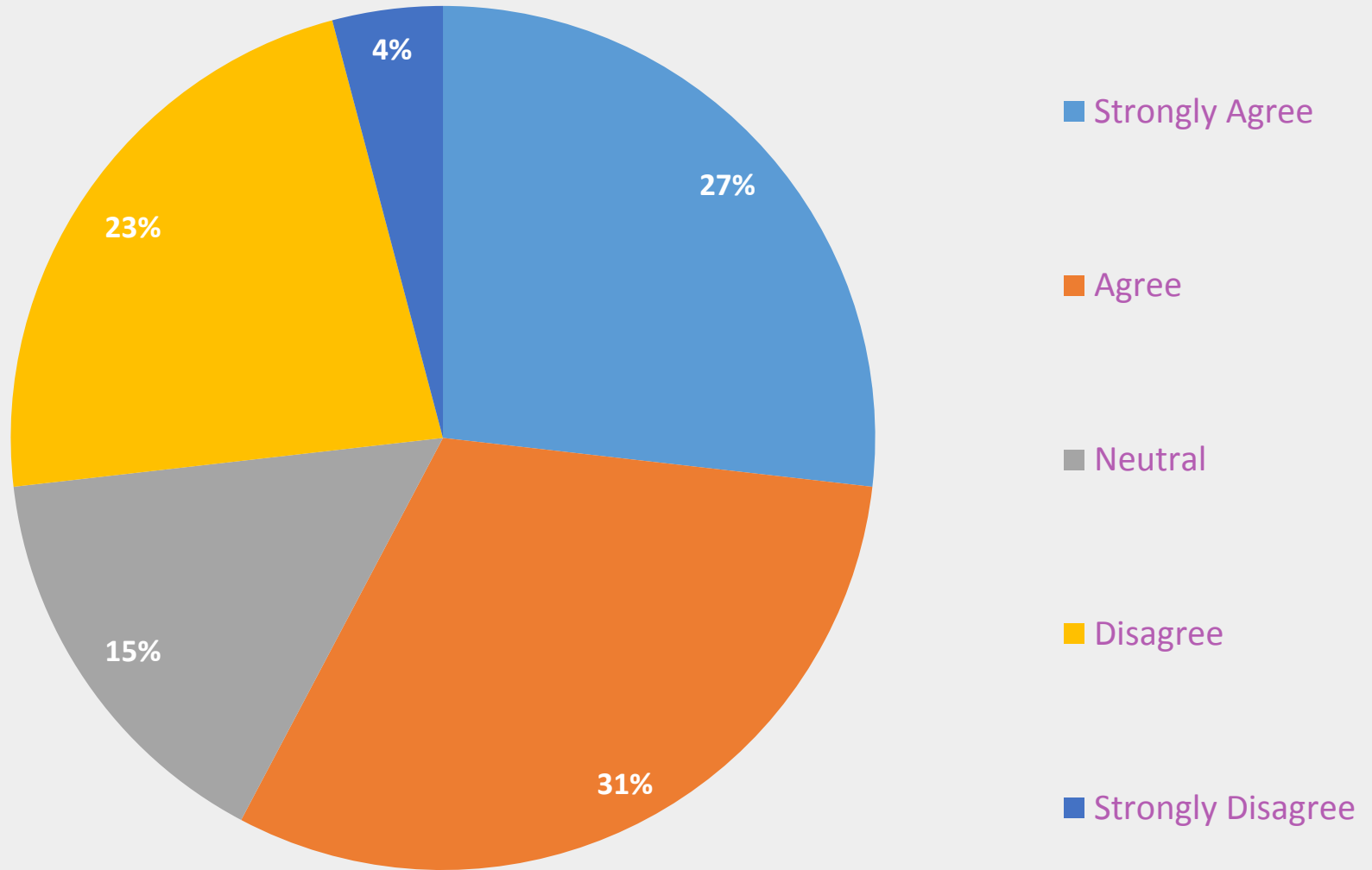
- Need for more training

Provider Discomfort

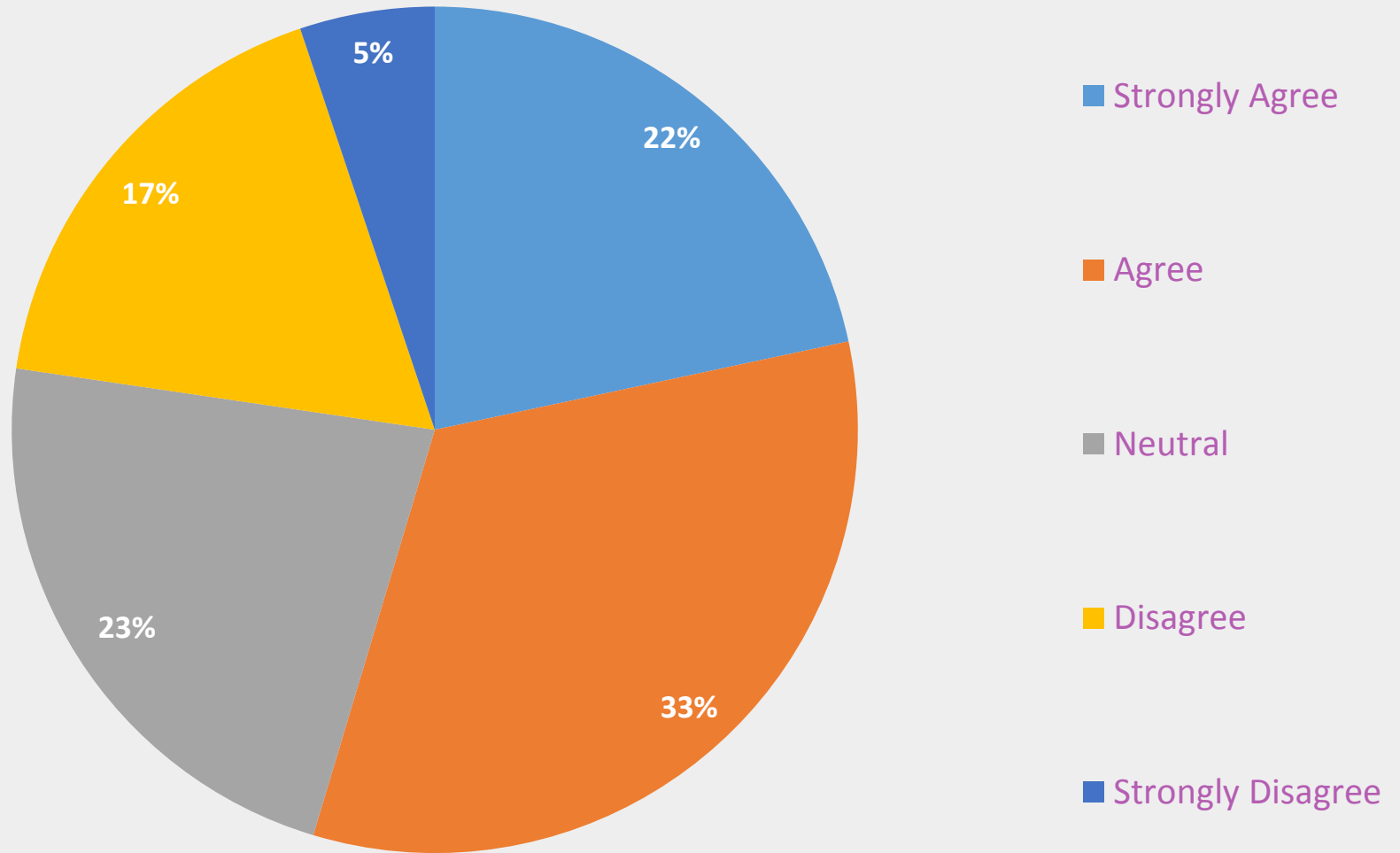
While some questions focused on sexual health and adolescents, the participants consistently reported similar concerns about adolescent health generally.

- ❖ Time management

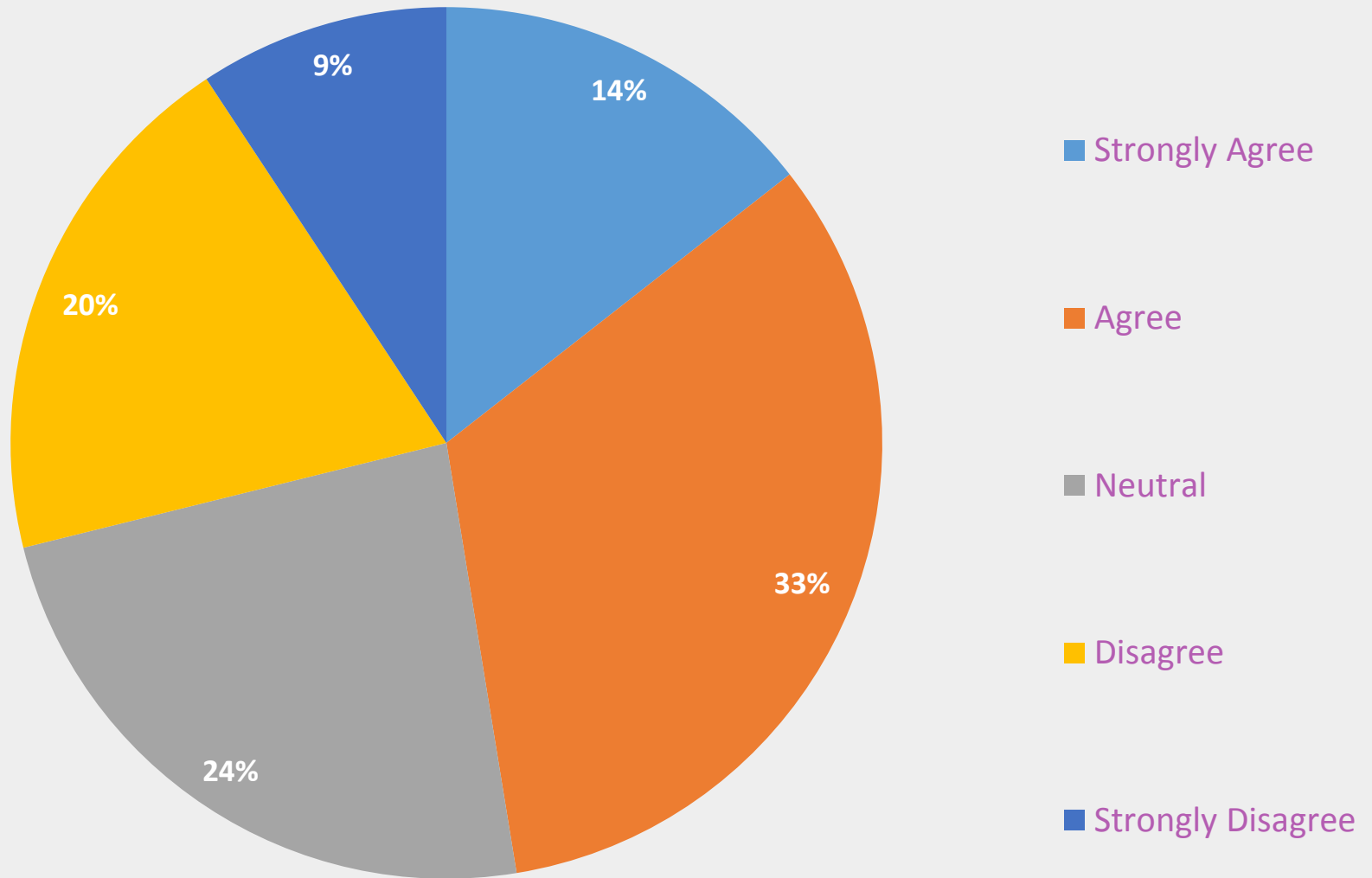

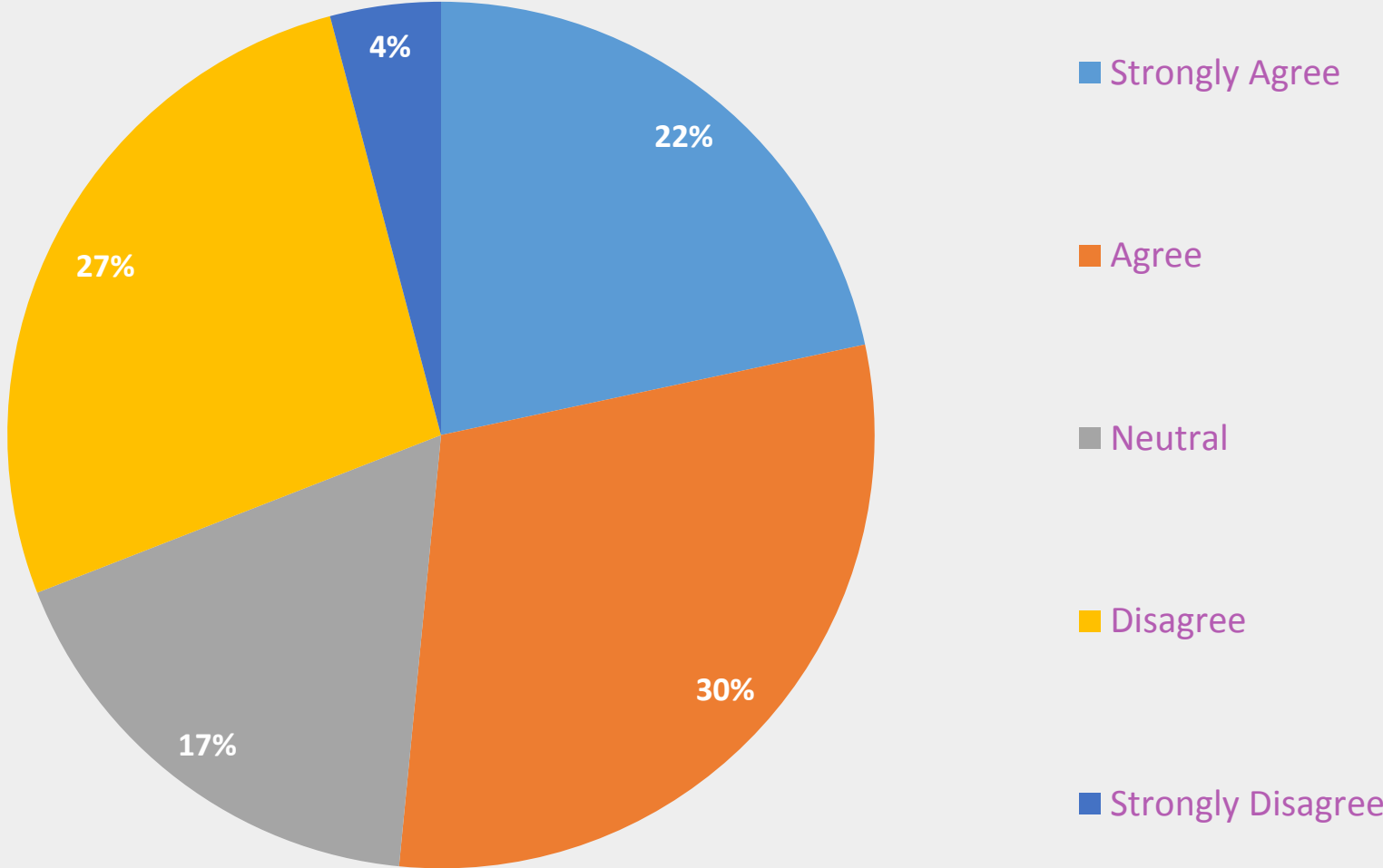

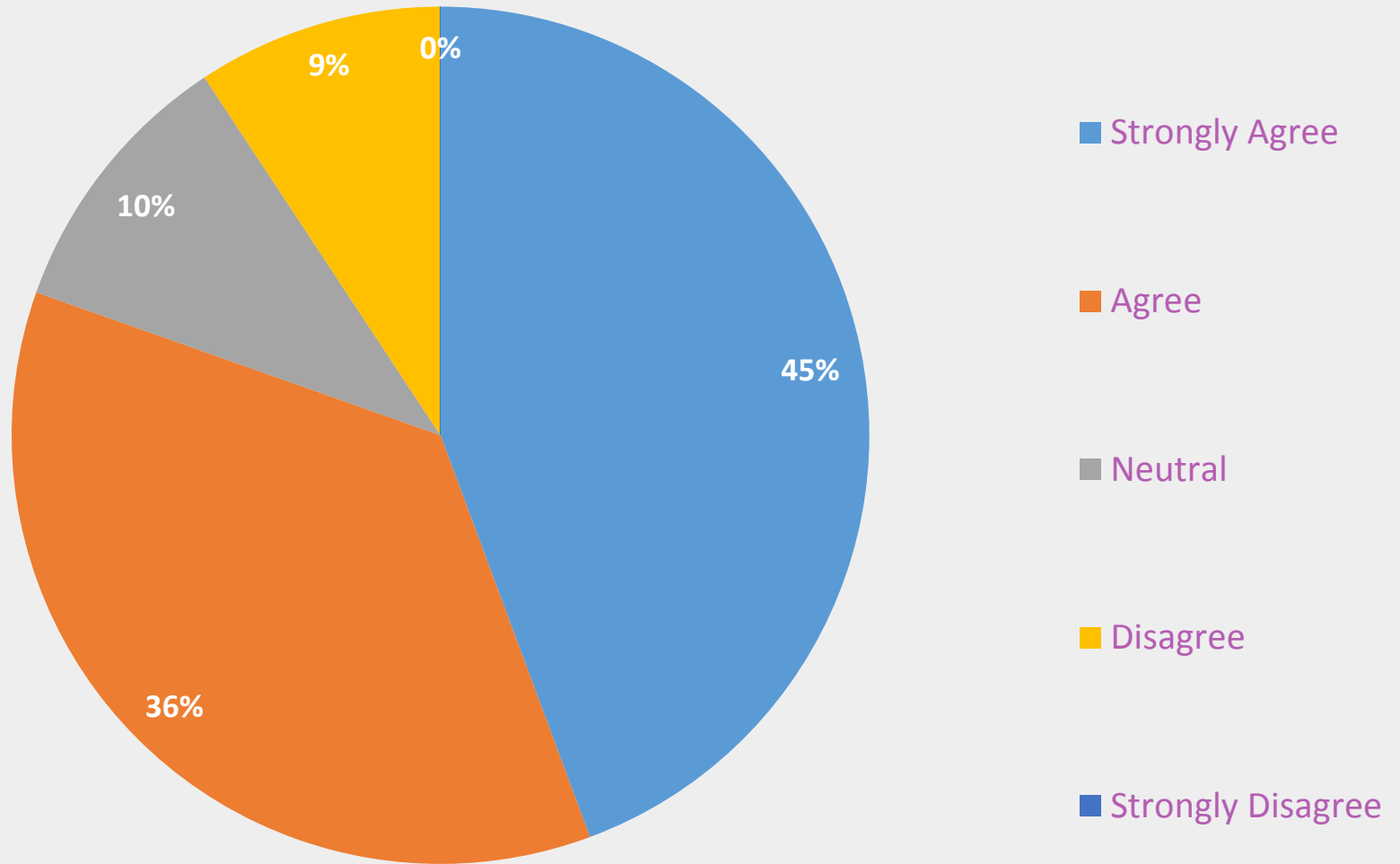

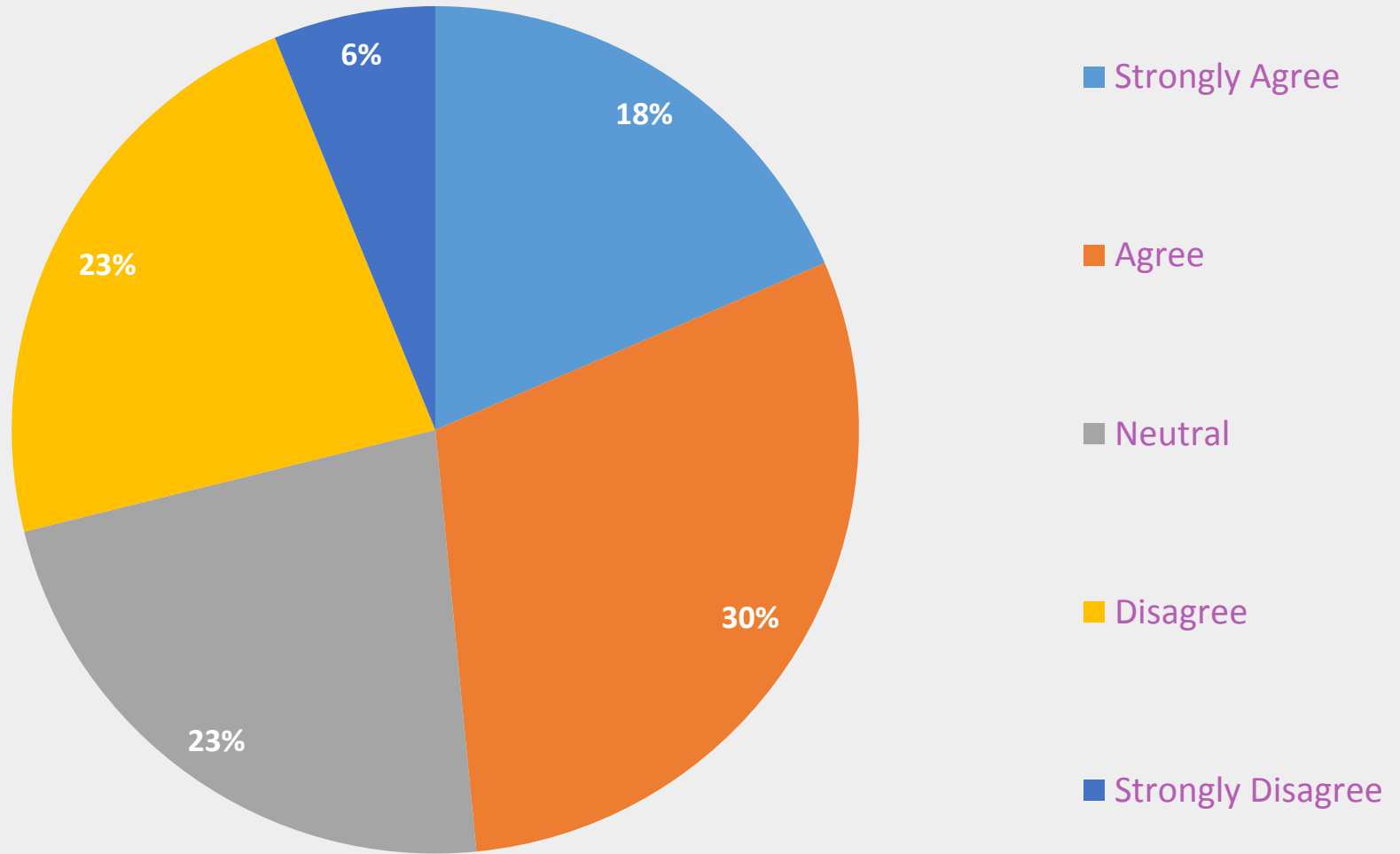

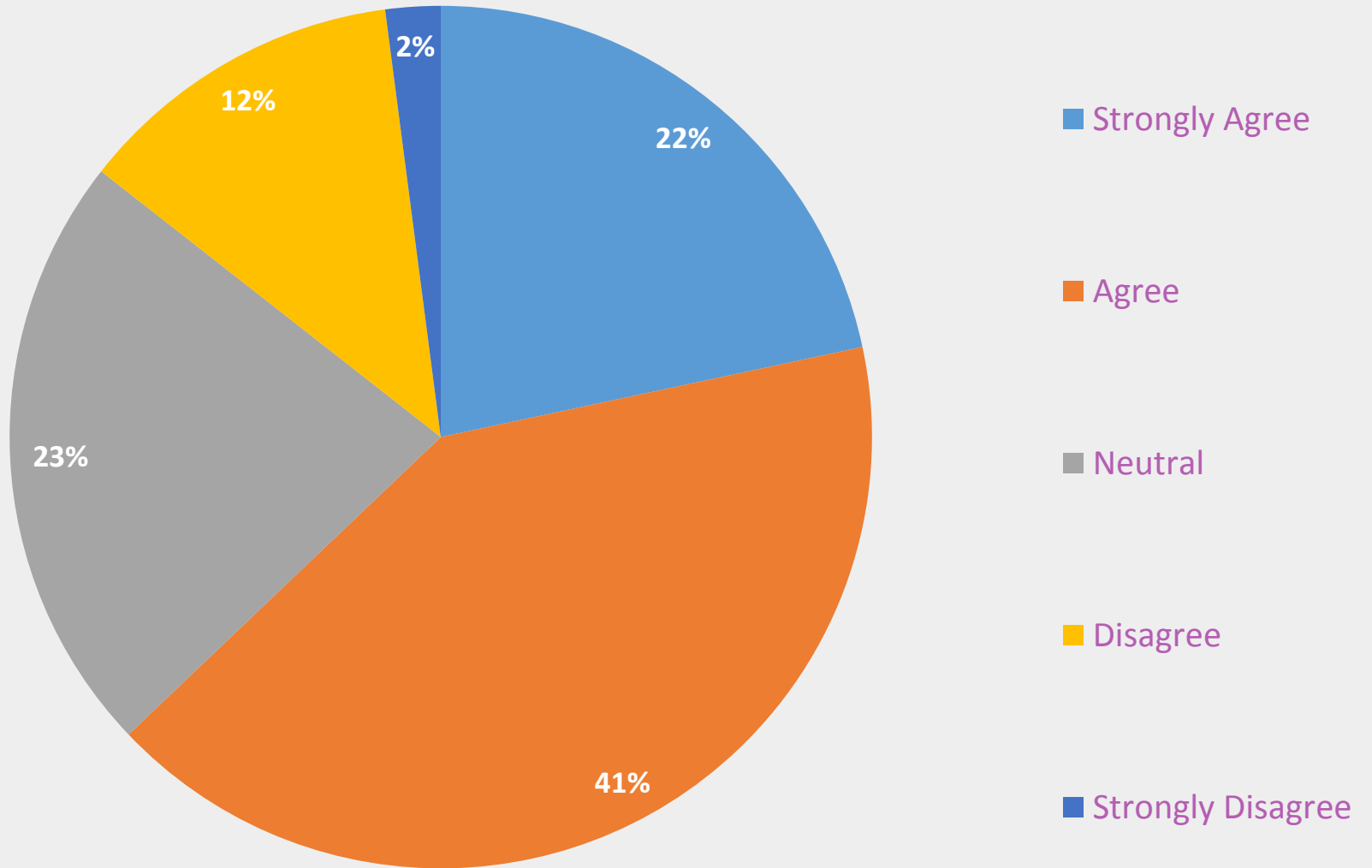
Perceptions of Adolescent Discomfort

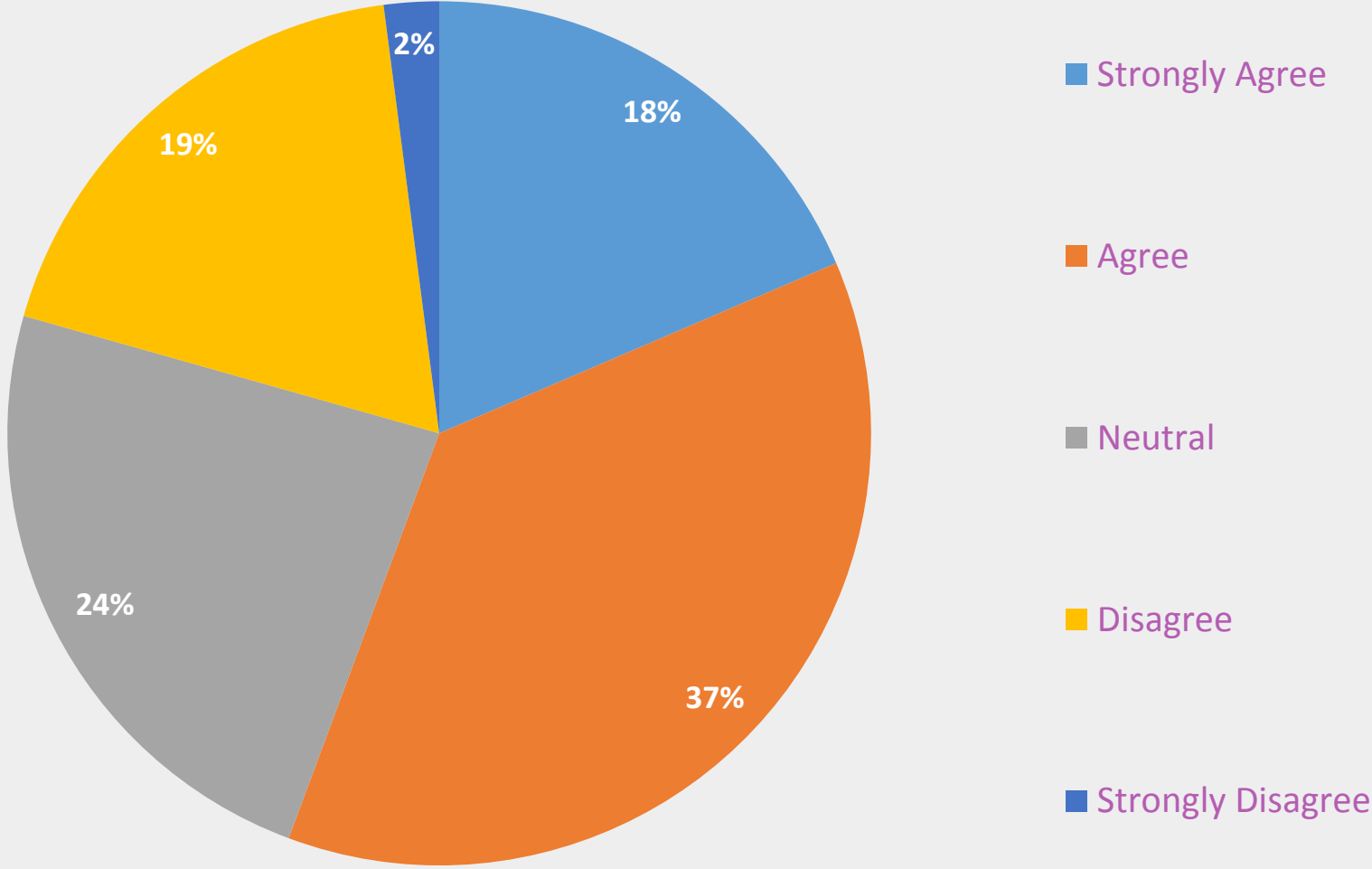

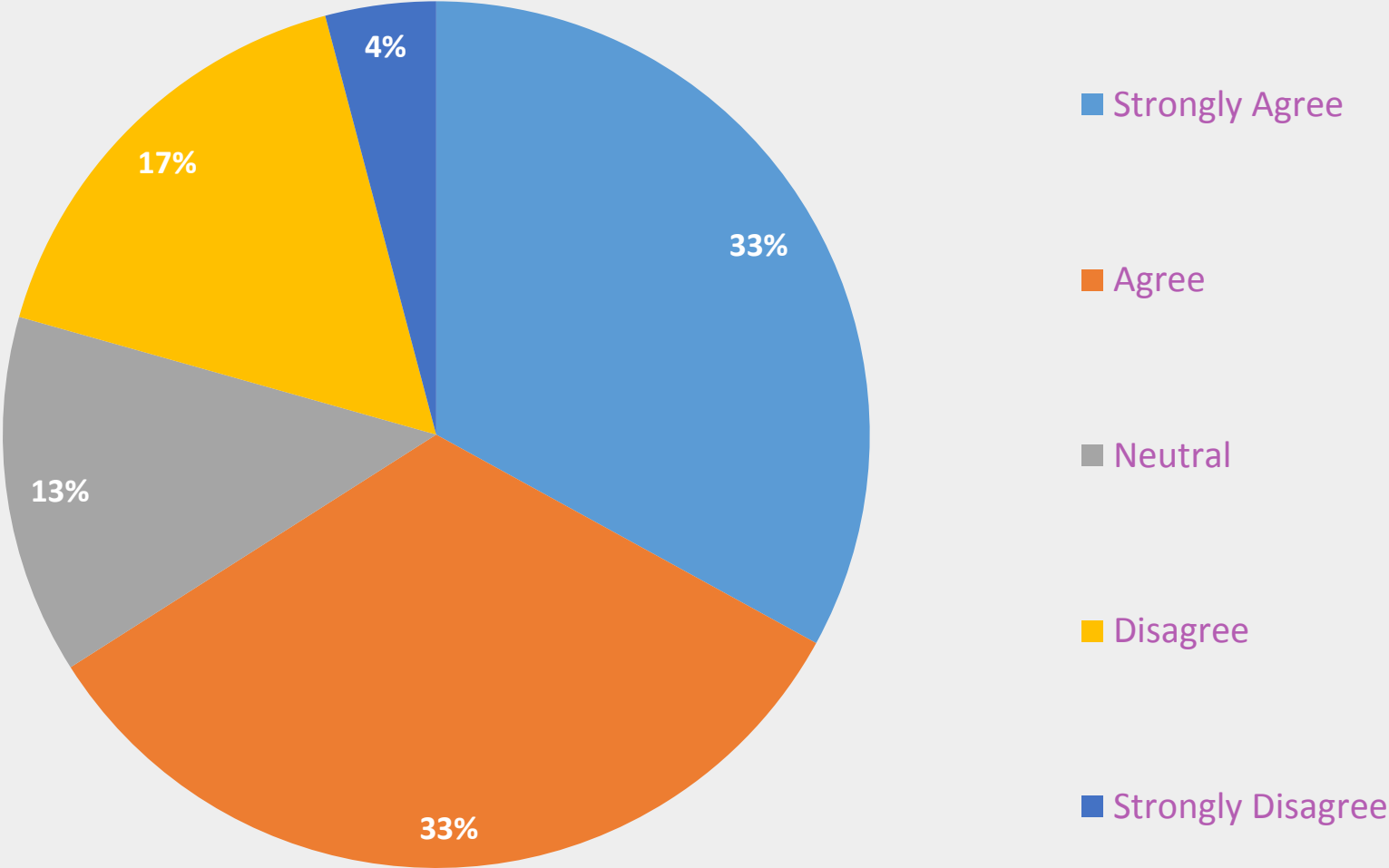
Interprofessionalism and Cross-System Care Coordination

The focus of these responses highlights the need for additional collaboration among all service providers and within the communities.

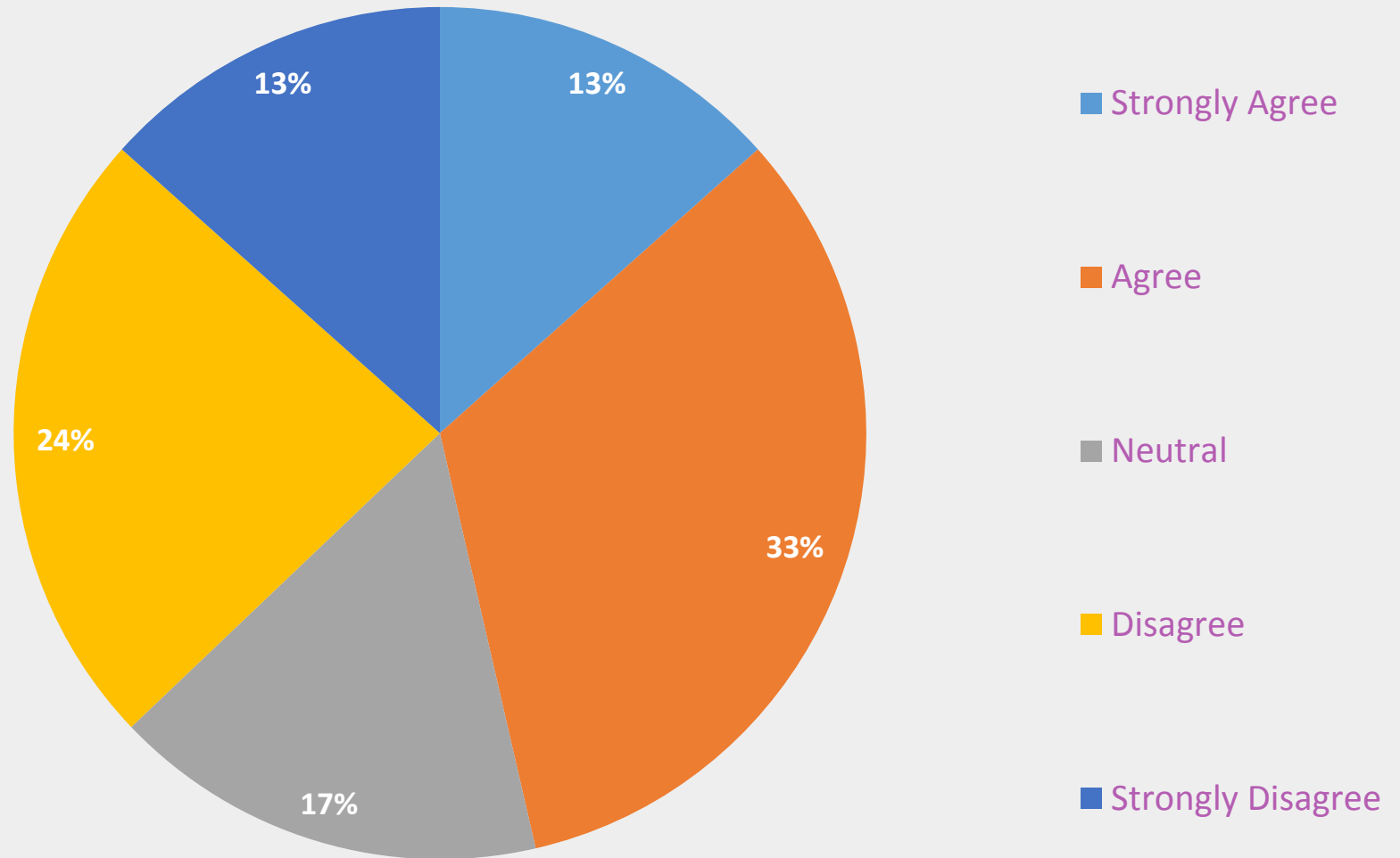

LACK OF CONFIDENCE IN ABILITY TO TREAT OR MANAGE PATIENTS WHO ARE HIV-POSITIVE

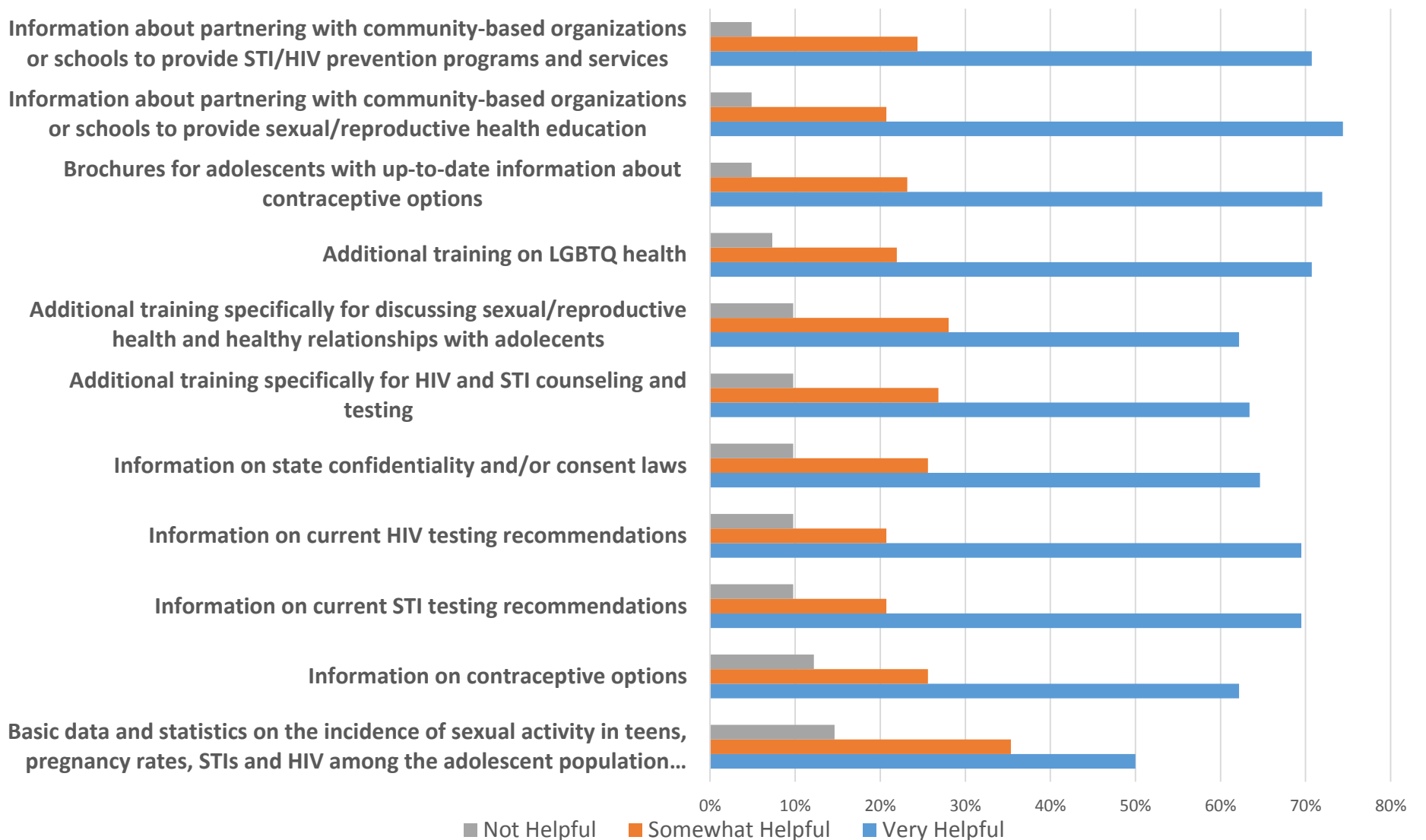


LACK OF CONFIDENCE IN ABILITY TO COUNSEL PATIENTS IN STI AND HIV PREVENTION

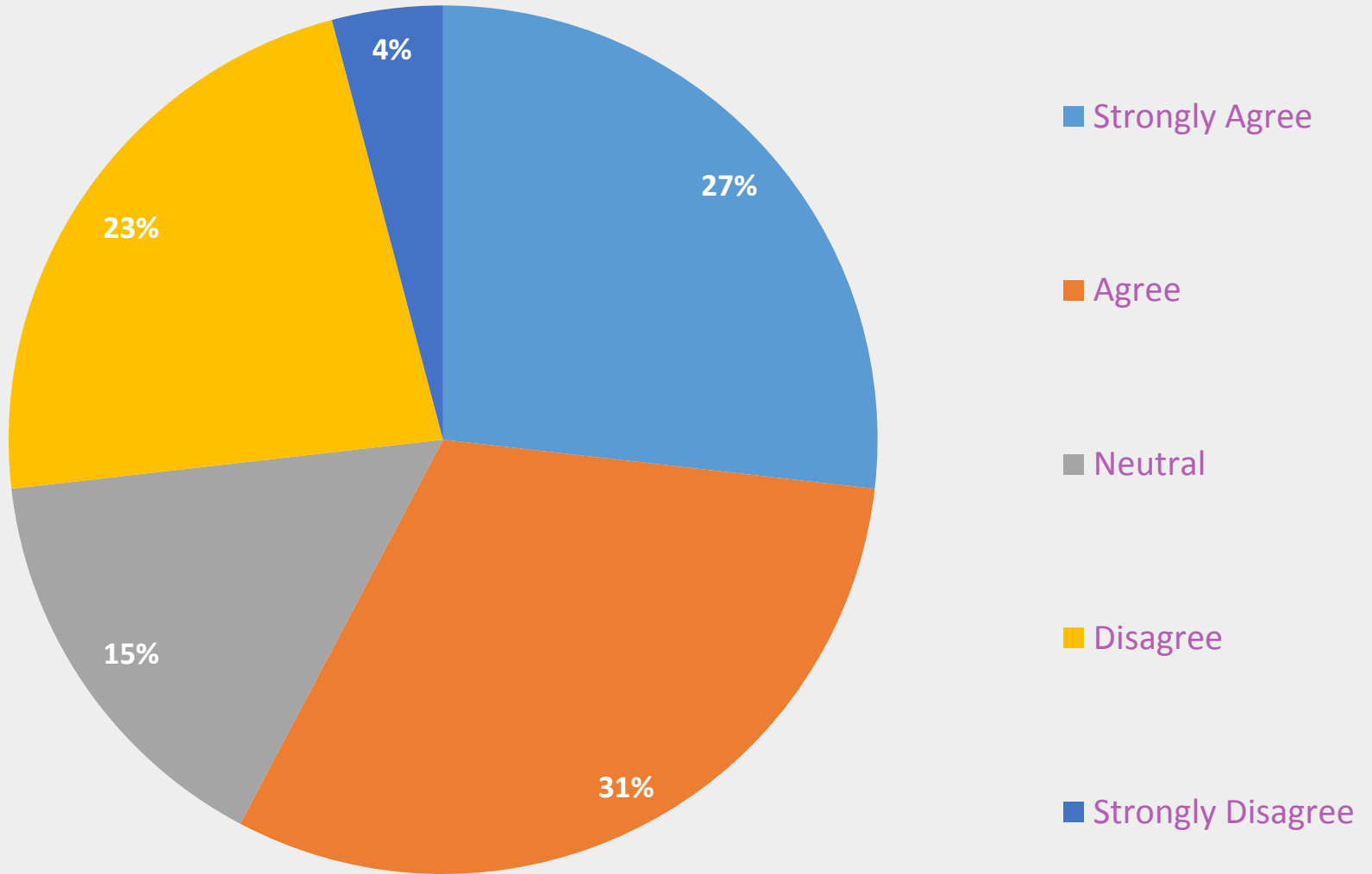

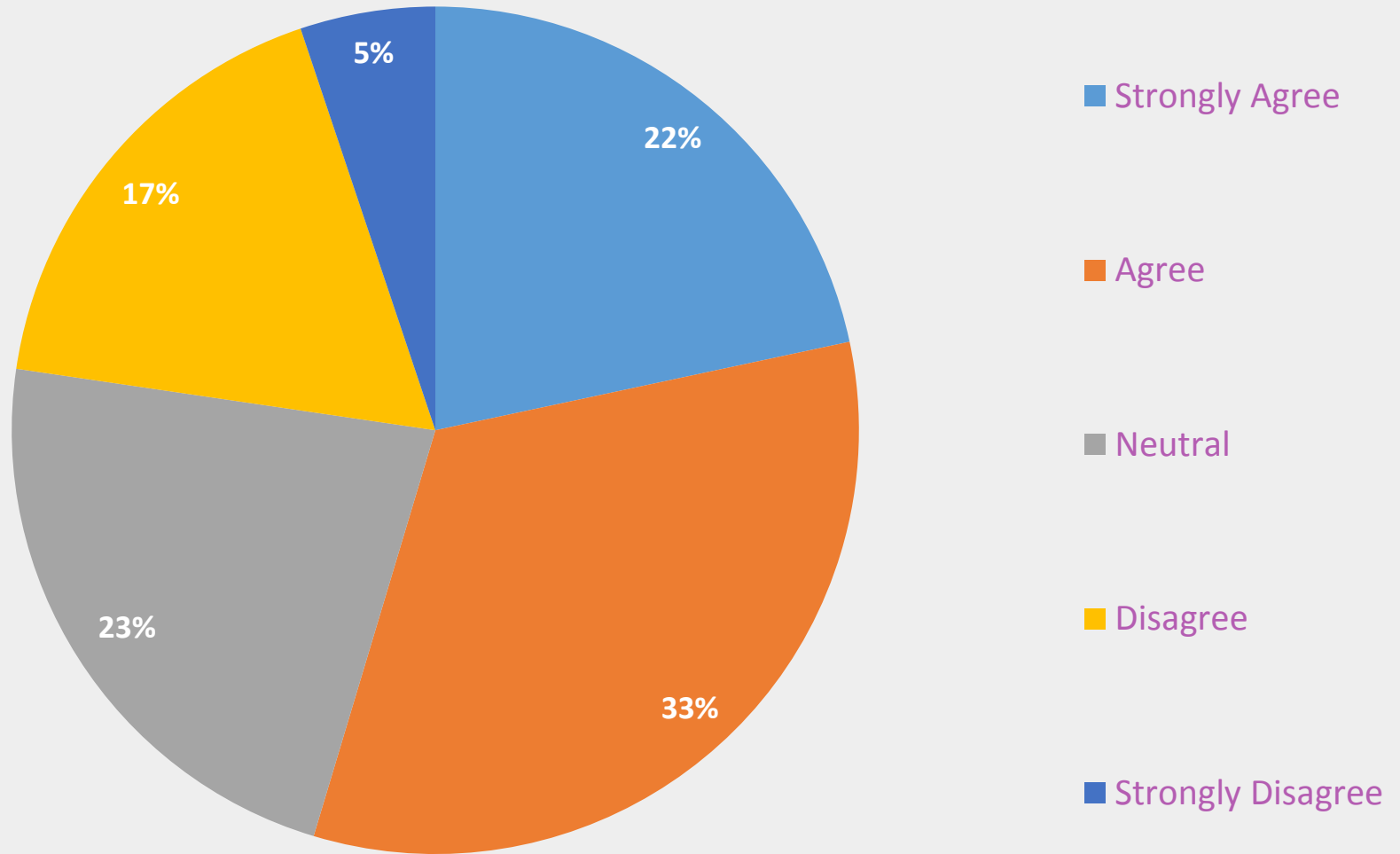

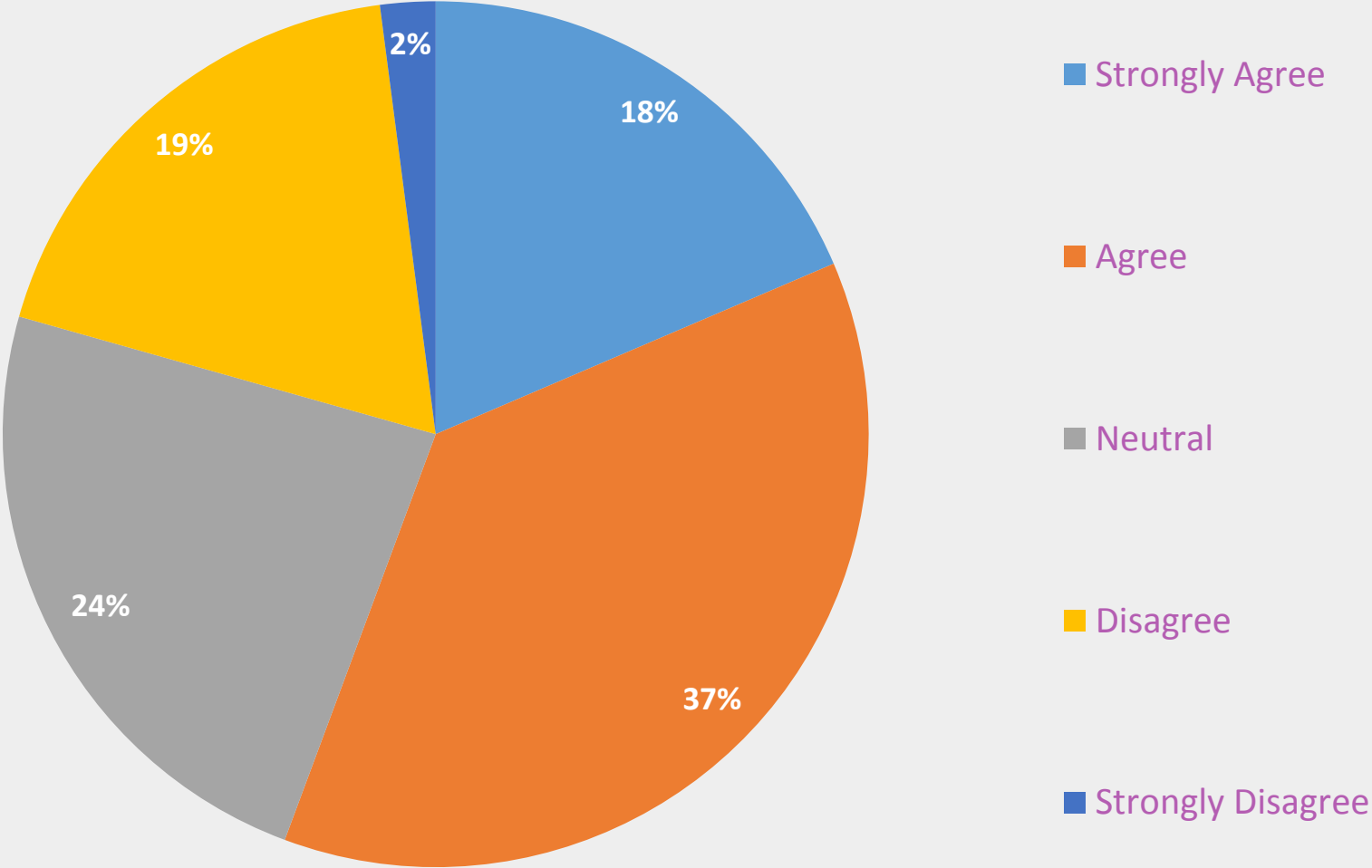

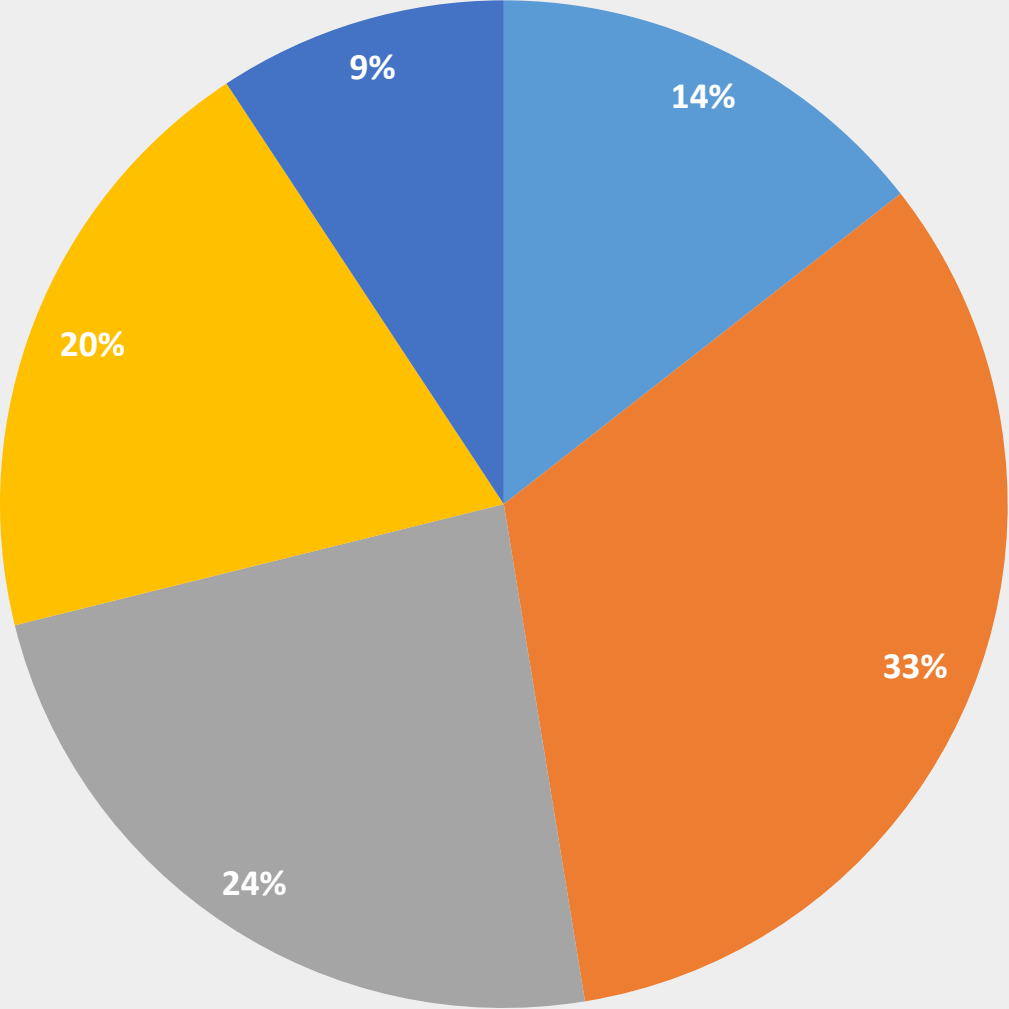

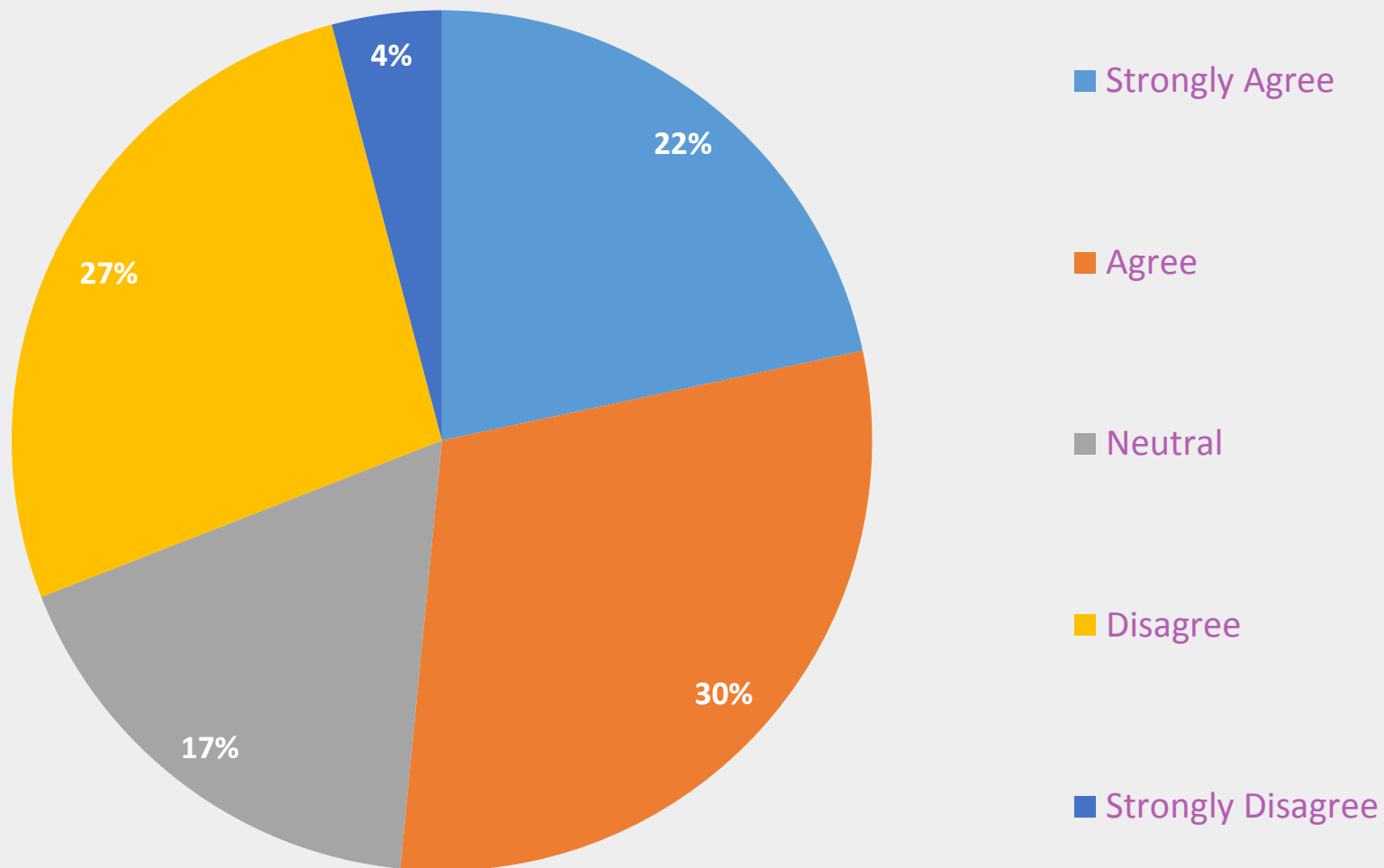

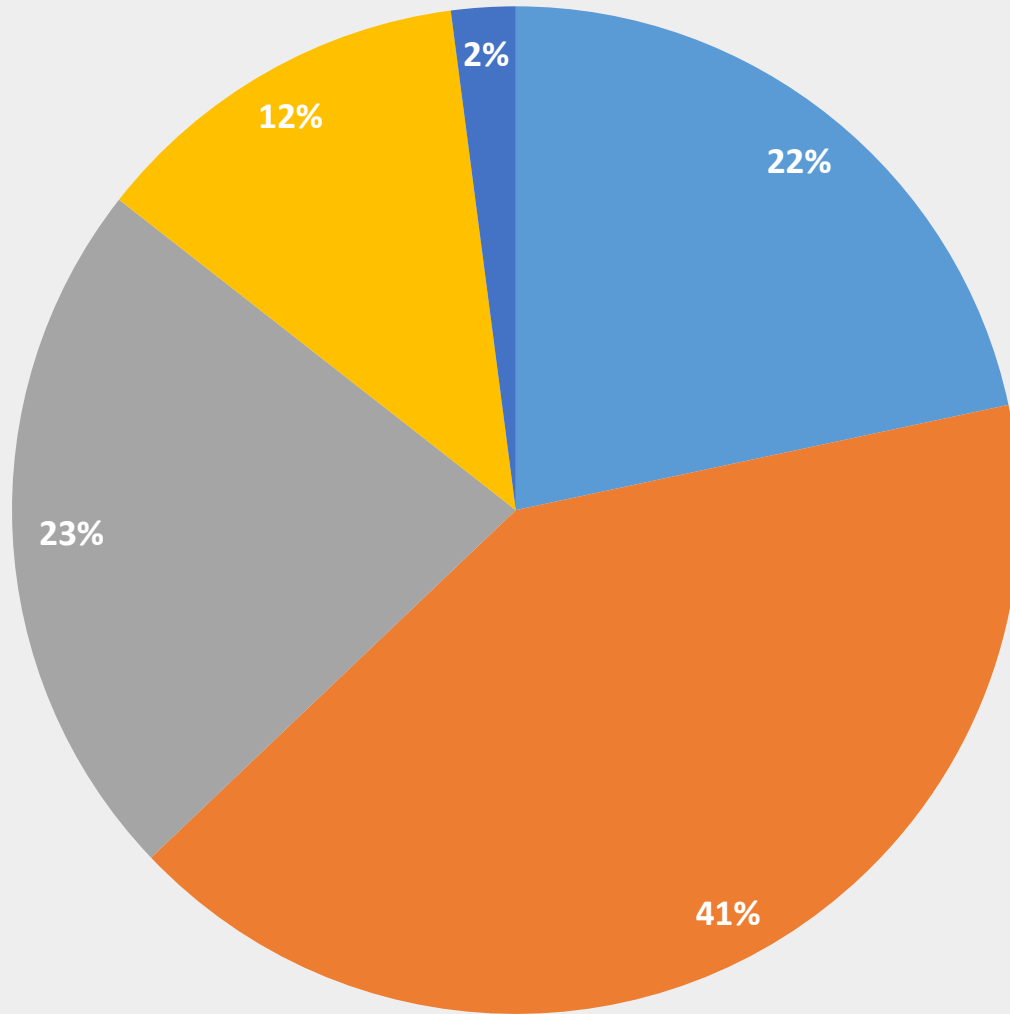

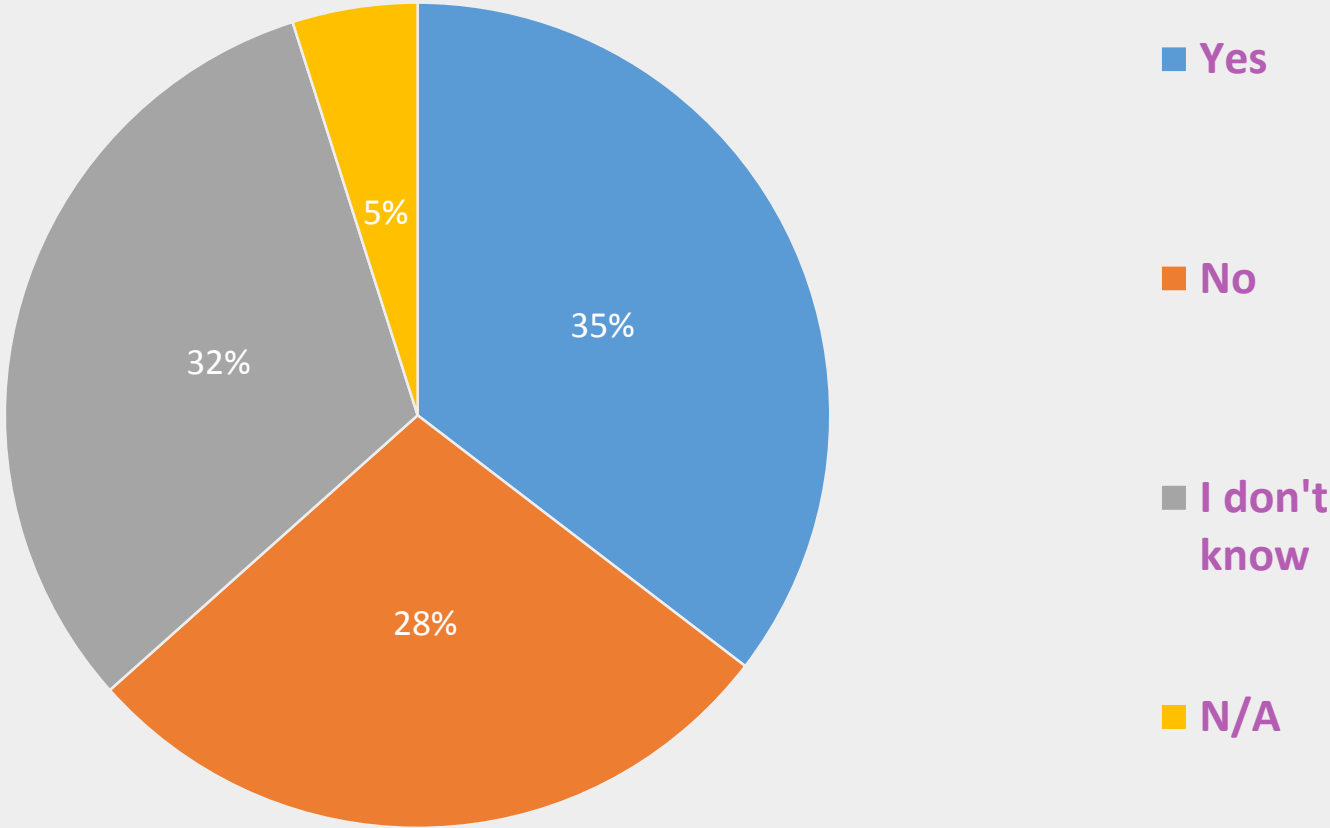

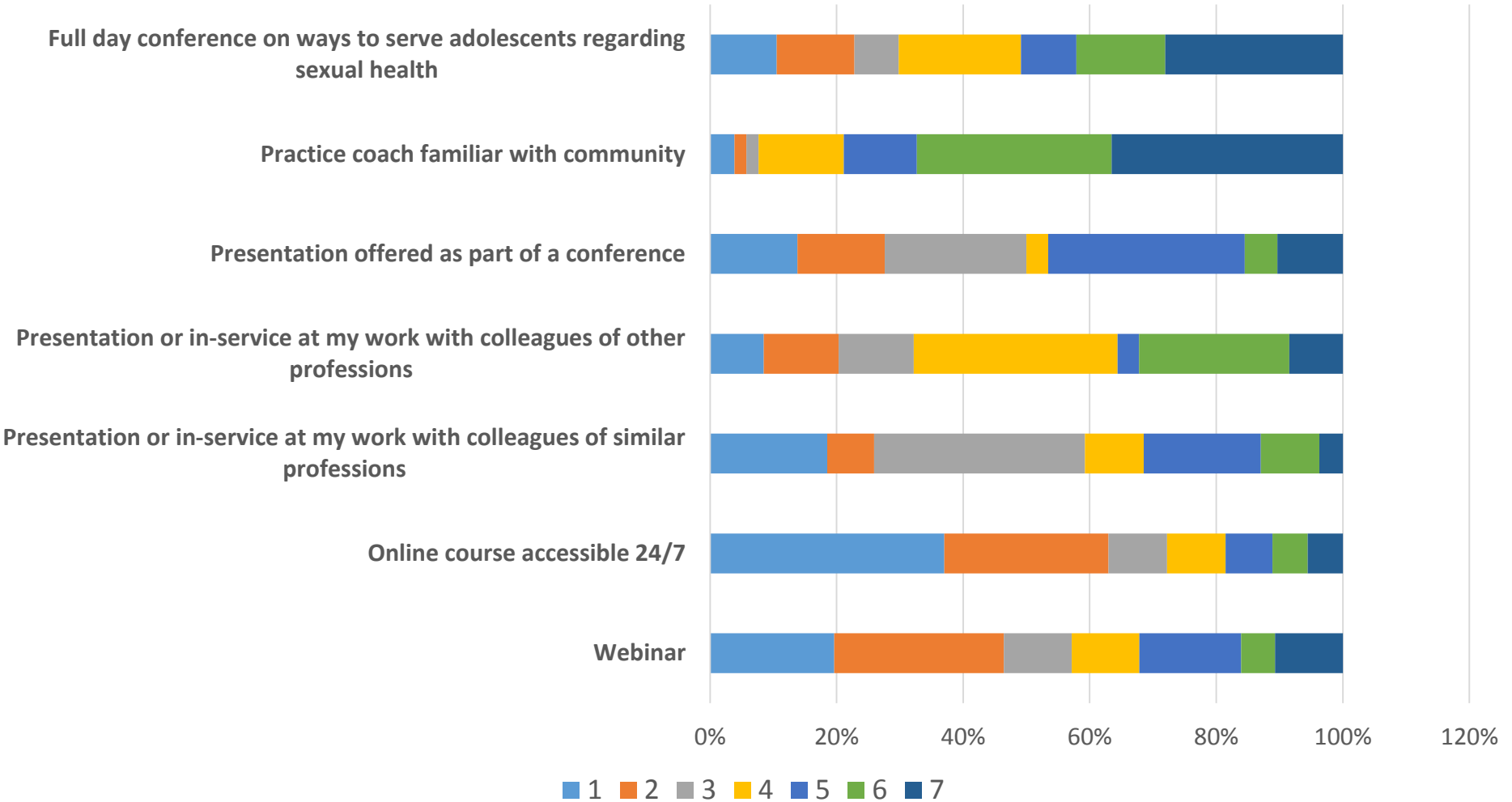

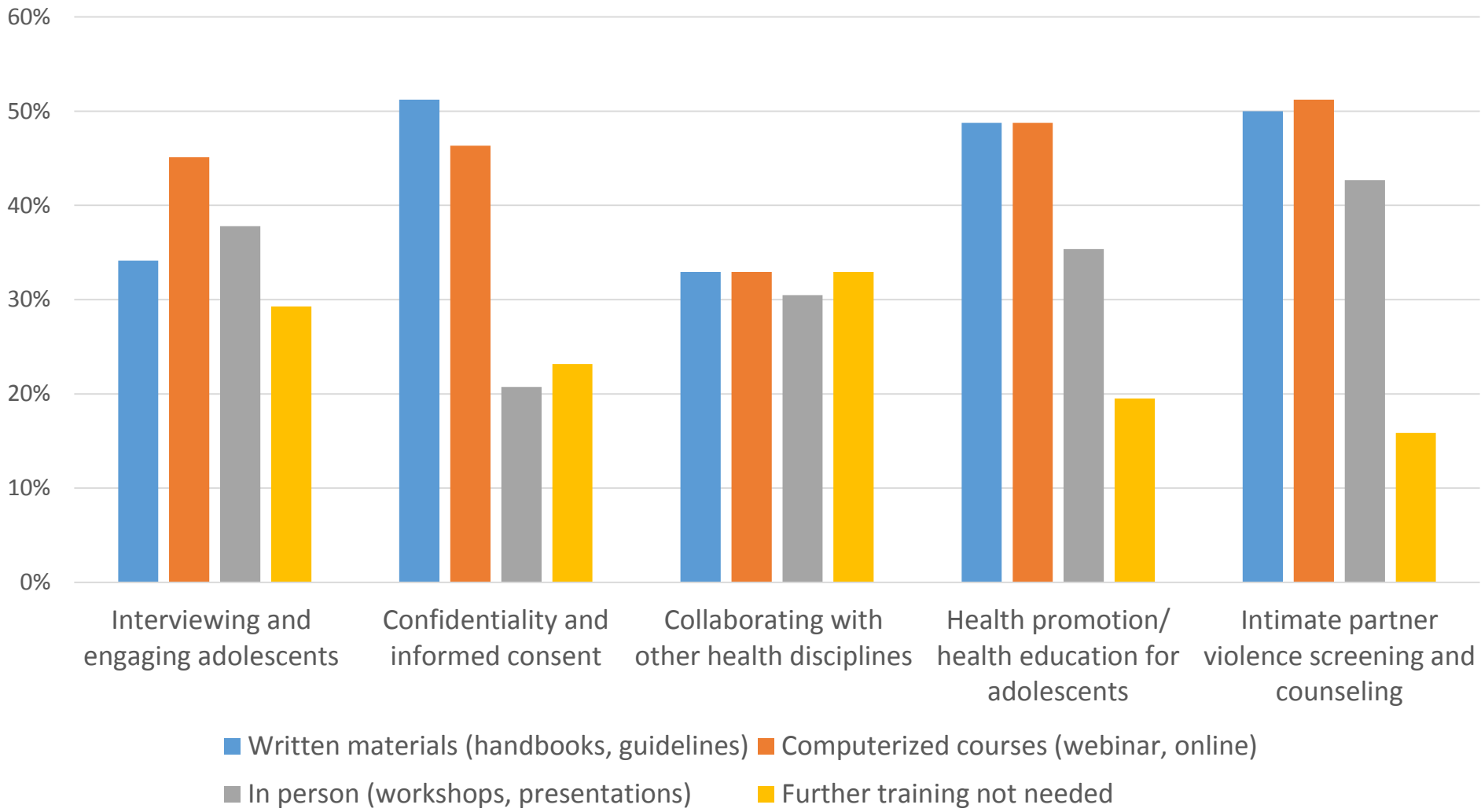
Do you currently have the opportunity to receive training about providing adolescent sexual/reproductive health services?



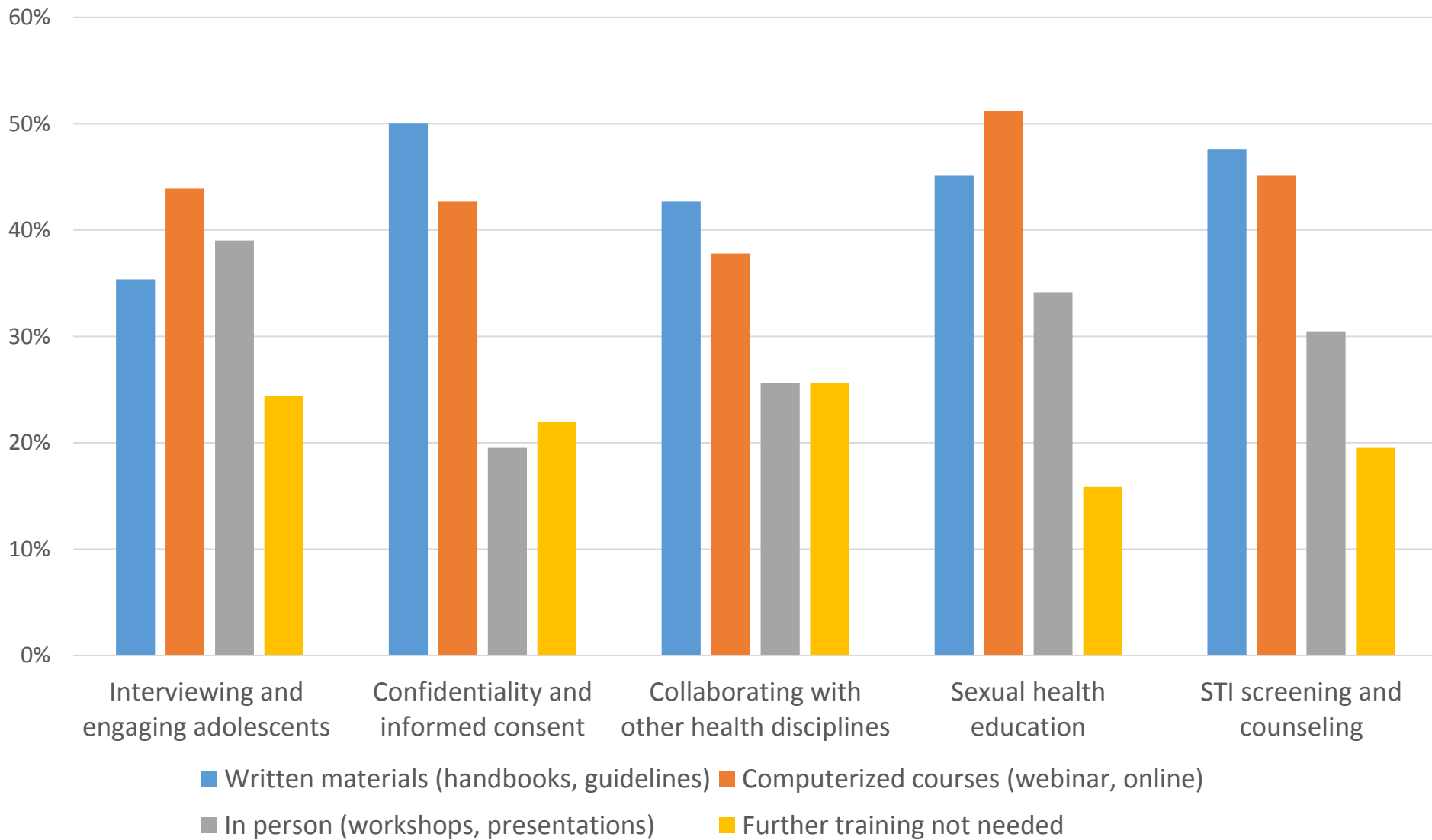
What format(s) of training do you prefer? Please rate 1 being most preferred and 7 being least preferred



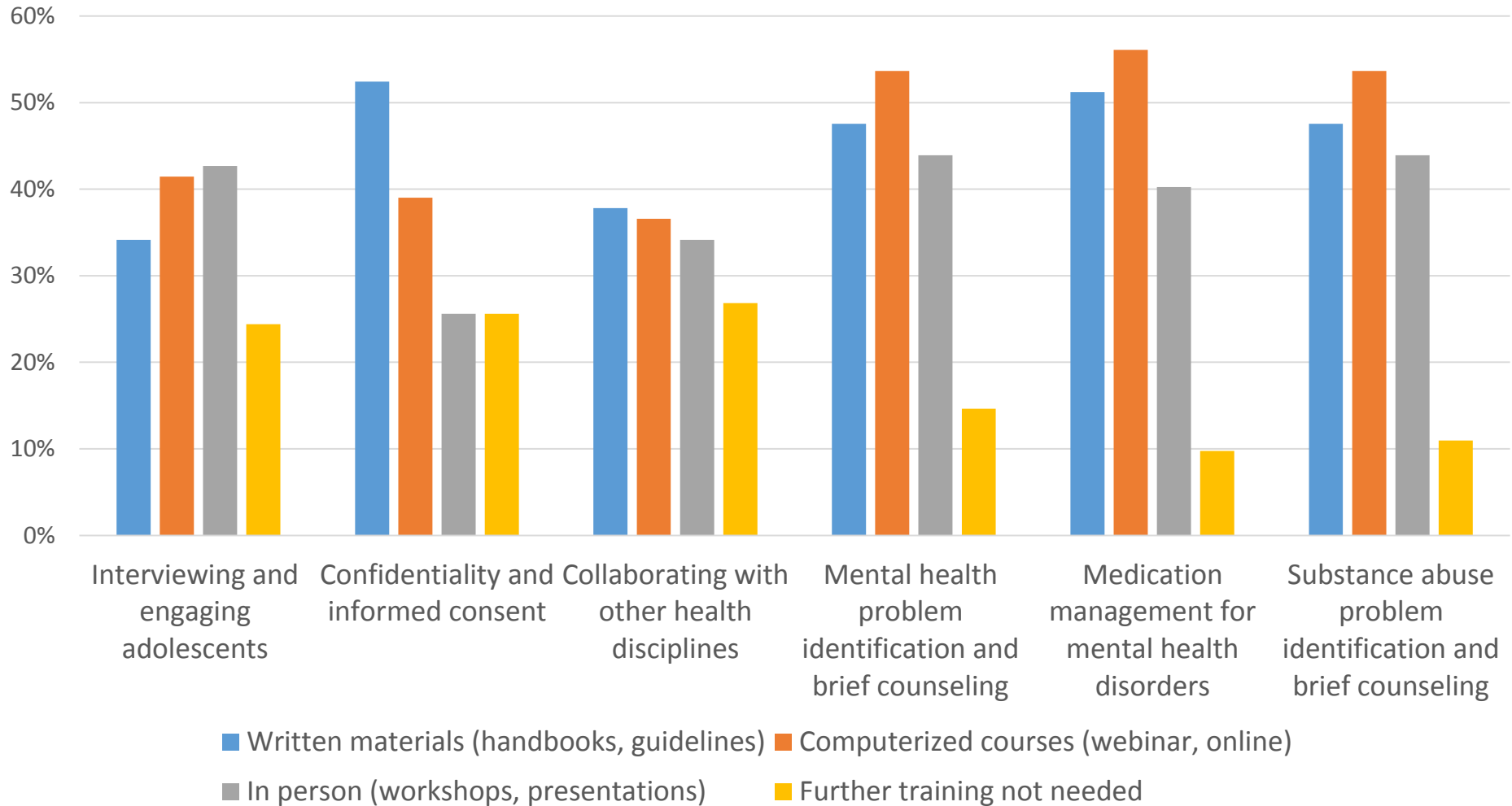
What subject areas and types of training would be most helpful for you in your work to provide **general health** care to adolescents?
