**Office Use:** The *Transition Checklist for Parents/Caregivers* was developed for use with **caregivers** of patients unlikely to achieve health care independence due to intellectual/developmental disabilities. The caregivers of these patients need to be prepared for the transition to the adult medical system. This checklist can help the clinician assess readiness of the youth and family to transition to adult systems by determining the health care tasks the caregiver currently performs, identifying the potential of the patient to learn new skills, and identifying areas for education and practice. Ask caregivers of teens to complete the checklist to establish a baseline and then reassess as needed (reassessment recommended every 12 months).
