Is the patient an (18-24) unaccompanied youth?

If yes, share:

- Ochicago: 311 to connect them to a youth specific shelter
- Outside of Chicago: 211 to connect them with youth specific resources
- streetlightchicago.org site or app to connect with Chicago-specific resources Available 24/7

For ages 11-17, share:

Is there domestic/intimate partner violence?

If yes, assess for safety;

involve police or DCFS if needed

Does the family currently have safe and stable housing?

For Chicago families:

- Advise patient to identify safe place to wait with their children (e.g., a hospital) and share 311 to secure transport to a shelter - OR -
- Refer them to Emergency Homeless Assessment and Response Center (EHARC) at 924 N. Christiana for shelter placement

For families outside Chicago: Share Suburban Cook County Homeless Prevention Call Center: (877) 426-6515 | M-F 8:30-4:30

Chicago Coordinated Entry Waiting List Application 211 or (312) 971-4178 | M, W-F 9am-3pm or T 3-9pm or check Housing Assessment Locations

Pregnancy is considered a factor for housing prioritization

Eviction Legal Services

Rental Assistance Application

- Chicago: 311 and ask for "Short Term Help" to cover rent, mortgage, and utilities
