Understanding VFC Program Eligibility

Are you concerned about being able to pay for life-saving vaccines for your child? Your child may be eligible for the Vaccines for Children (VFC) program, which offers low - no cost vaccines.


Children eligible for the VFC program include those 18 years and younger who:

- Do not have insurance
- Are “underinsured” – meaning they have insurance, but it does not pay for the cost of vaccines
- Are enrolled in Medicaid
- Are American Indian or Alaska Native – regardless of insurance status

The VFC program covers all recommended vaccines:

- ✓ Measles, Mumps, Rubella (MMR)
- ✓ HPV
- ✓ Polio
- ✓ Influenza or flu
- ✓ And more!
