Why is ICAAP upgrading its LMS?

ICAAP is upgrading from Remote Learner to Learning Experience Platform (LXP) to provide a more modern, engaging, and effective learning experience. While the current LMS has served us well, we wanted a platform that is more interactive, multimedia-rich, and responsive to individual needs.

What do ICAAP members want from an LMS?

Executive Board input from 2024 highlighted a clear desire for:

- More interactivity
- Real-time feedback during training (e.g., instant quiz results)
- Use of videos and multimedia
- Animated and engaging course content
- Knowledge checks before moving forward
- A clean, intuitive course and platform design

What is the difference between Remote Learner and LXP?

- Remote Learner is a traditional learning platform focused on content delivery.
- LXP is learner-centered. It personalizes the journey, offers interactive tools, and enables features like content recommendations, skill tracking, and dynamic course design.

How will the new platform improve the training experience?

- Interactive content and animations to keep you engaged.
- Built-in videos seamlessly integrated with written material.
- Knowledge checks that gate progression and boost retention.
- Real-time feedback on quizzes and learning activities.
- Modern design for both courses and platform navigation
- Customized learning paths tailored to your interests or certification needs

Will past course completions/certificates transfer over?

No. Your previously completed courses from Remote Learner will not show up in the LXP. ICAAP has learning history, should a learner need them in the future.

Will this affect CME or CE eligibility?

No. The new platform will continue to support all existing accreditation standards and improve the ease of tracking and reporting your continuing education.

When will the new system go live?

December 1, 2025. Course structures and opportunities for interaction will evolve as we continue to learn and apply the features of the new system!

Will I get certificates the same way/through the new LMS?

No. ICAAP is moving to one platform for all certificates. Course evaluations and certificates will be completed through Jotform and emailed directly to you so that you will not need to go into the LMS for them! ICAAP staff will be able to resend you a certificate any time you need one. Note that MOC Part IV certificates may be issued differently.
