

Hospitals/Healthcare Settings: IDPH

Hello,

As of March 1st, 2026 all hospitals licensed by the Illinois Department of Public Health are required to develop and submit a policy relating to interactions with law enforcement agents to the Department. Additionally, hospitals must post the following information in a visible and accessible location:
